Sunday March 7th begins with
a calm and light airs from all around
the compass steered N.W. had it
rain most all the latter part saw nothing
do ends Lat 04.52 Long 15.18

Monday March 8th begins with
calm and light airs from all around
the compass fresh breeze latter part
from N.E. steered by the wind on
the Starboard tack do ends Lat 04.59 Long 15.45

Tuesday March 9th begins with
fine weather light breeze from North
by East steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack the watch employed
variously saw nothing do ends Lat 04.49 Long none

Wednesday March 10th begins with
rain squally weather squalls calm light
from all around the compass steered N.W.
fine weather latter part light breeze
from N.E. steered by the wind
on the Starboard tack do ends
Lat 04.34 Long 17.53

Thursday March 11th begins with
fine weather light breeze from N.E.
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack The Cook had been below
about 10 days under the pretence of
being sick he said he would go to work
if he could be a foremast hand so
he had gone to duty and Antonio Michel
is the Cook now saw nothing do ends Lat 04.36 Long 19.08

Friday March 12th begins with
fine weather light breeze from
North steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack. Watch employed bending
a new Main top Gallant sail and repairing
the old one do ends Lat 04.32 Long 20.33

Saturday March 13th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
North steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack the watch employed
boiling over potatoes &c do ends Lat 04.54 Long 22.01

Sunday March 14th begins with
fine weather light breeze from N.W.
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack good breeze latter part from
N.E. saw nothing do ends Lat 05.15 Long 23.31

Monday March 15th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
N.E. steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack saw ten or twelve sails
all going southwards do ends
Lat 06.20 Long 25.16
