Saturday Apr 24th begins with
fine weather light air from North
steered by the wind on the starboard
tack had it calm all the latter part
the watch employed repairing the fore
top sail saw nothing to end Lat none Long none

Sunday Apr 25th begins with
light air from East steered by
the wind had it calm all the
latter part saw two humpbacks at 7 am
covered 3 boats at but did not strike
to end Lat 29 59 Long 41 23

Monday Apr 26th begins with
a calm the watch employed repairing
the fore sail saw some
Grampuses and two sails to end
Lat 30 03 Long 41 11

Tuesday Apr 27th begins with
light air from S W steered East
~~the~~ the watch employed variously
saw two sails to end Lat 30 22 Long 40 33

Wednesday Apr 28th begins with
light breeze from West steered East
saw a large lone sperm whale at 3 pm
8 miles off going quick to the S W covered
3 boats at 4 pm chased him til 7 pm
and got within 2 1/2 miles of him at 7
boats got aboard at 8 pm wind from
W S W latter part to end Lat 29 52 Long 40 28

Thursday Apr 29th begins with
fine weather light breeze from W S W
steered by the wind fore part steered
N E latter part to end Lat 30 04 Long 40 09

Friday Apr 30th begins with
fine weather good breeze from S S W
steered N E by East shortened sail
at dark strong breeze and rainy latter part
saw one sail to end Lat 31 06 Long 38 31

Saturday Chafert begins with
fresh breeze with rain from
S S W steered by the wind on the
starboard tack shortened sail at dark
saw two sails to end Lat 30 31 Long 36 13
