Sunday May 2nd Begins with
fresh breezes from NW Steered
ESE shortened sail at dark Strong breezes
latter part Steered East to end Lat 31 12 Long 33 08

Monday May 3rd Begins with
strong breezes from NW Steered E by
North half a Gale latter part laid back
to latter part under close reefed main
top sail to end Lat 31 28 Long 33 53

Tuesday May 4th Begins with
a moderate Gale laid back to under
close reefed main top sail latter
weather latter part Steered ESE under
double reefed top sails to end Lat 32 00 Long 33 01

Wednesday May 5th Begins with
strong breezes from NW Steered ESE
under double reefed top sails had it
foggy latter part Steered SE NNE
Lat 32 45 Long 32 30

Thursday May 6th Begins with
strong breeze from NW Steered
NWSE wind from NW latter
part shortened sail at dark saw nothing
to end Lat 32 55 Long 32 05

Friday May 7th Begins with
strong breezes from NW Steered
NE shortened sail at dark the
watch employed variously saw one Finback
and one Hail to end Lat 33 28 Long 31 40

Saturday May 8th Begins with
strong breezes from NW Steered NNE
at 4 PM closed reefed the topsails and
luffed to the wind on the Port tack
steered NE latter part to end Lat 36 30 Long 31 10

Sunday May 9th Begins with
half a Gale from NW Steered ESE
at 6 PM luffed to the wind under close
reefed top sails latter weather latter part
steered by the wind on the Port tack under
double reefed topsails to end Lat 37 10 Long 30 48

Monday May 10th Begins with
fresh breezes from NW Steered by the
wind on the Port tack saw two Bails
and two Finbacks fine weather latter
part the day to end Lat 38 04 Long 30 15

Tuesday May 11th Begins with
fine weather good breezes from
NW Steered East till dark and shortened
sail saw the Island of Pico at 10 AM 70 miles
of bearing East by North to end Lat 37 58 Long 29 38
