

Bark Mary Grazer of New Bedford
Sunday August 1st 1869.

Commenced the month, week, and this page
 Strong breeze from N.W. steering S.W. saw several
 steamers, ships and firebricks latter part
 wind and weather the same steering S.W.
 then to E., saw nothing but ships. lat 48.24 lon 19.19

Monday 2nd

Fine weather with wind from N.W. and backing
 to W. and clouding up steering to N.E. till
 sunset, when luffed by wind to W. wore ship at
 seven A.M. latter part fog, and strong breeze
 from W.S.W. and so ends. No Obs.



Tuesday 3rd

Commenced with strong breeze from W. and
 foggy lowered and struck a sunfish. wind freshening
 to a gale. at seven P.M. wore ship to N.W.
 latter part wind the same with rain and fog
 lowered and picked up a lower mast, belonging
 to some small square rigged vessel. the lower rigging
 attached, had been in the water but a short time

Wednesday 4th

Commenced with wind W. and fog. but clearing
 some. made sail and steering N.E. then wore and
 steering S.W. till sunset when heading by wind to S.W.
 latter part steering S.W. till eight A.M. when
 steering E.N.E. with pleasant weather but strong breeze
 from W.N.W. one whaler in sight. lat 48.32 lon 17.55

Thursday 5th

Commenced with strong breeze from N.W. and
 cloudy, steering S.W. till sunset when luffed to wind
 to N. kept off at daylight steering E.N.E., till seven
 A.M. then E. one sail in sight. so ends.
 Fine weather with wind from N.W. lat 48.40 lon 16.30

Cruising in the North Atlantic
Friday August 6th 1869.

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant
 steering E. till two P.M. when steering S.E. till dark
 luffed to wind to W. wore round at twelve. kept
 off at daylight steering S.E. boarded the Bark
 Reinhardt of Bremen for New York, could get
 no crew from her. lat 48.17 lon 15.21

Saturday 7th

Commenced with fine weather and a fresh breeze
 from N. to N.W. steering S.E. till dark when luffed
 to wind to N.E. for half an hour when kept off
 S.E. under short sail latter part steering the
 same with all sail and so ends lat 48.28 lon 13.24

Sunday 8th

Commenced with the same wind from N. to N.W.
 steering to S.E. till four P.M. when hauled up
 to N by N. and carrying sail through the night
 latter part heading by wind to N by S. breeze freshening
 and some fog. so ends. lat 46.30 lon 15.23

Monday 9th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. to N.
 heading by wind to N by N. wind freshening, and
 some fog took in top gallant sails carrying sail
 through the night. latter part set main top
 gallant sail, and heading by wind to N.W.
 with fog squalls. so that can see nothing. lat 46.02
 lon 17.47

Tuesday 10th

Commenced with strong breeze from N. to N.W.
 and foggy took in main top gallant sail. heading
 by wind to N.W. latter part strong breeze
 from same heading by wind to N.W. by N.
 with clear weather. Broke out water in
 after hold and so ends lat 45.59 lon 20.00
