

Bark Mary Greaves of New Bedford

Thursday, March 3rd 1870.

Fresh breeze from E. kept off at daylight and at twelve (noon) came to anchor in 8 fathoms, washed ship outside, and secured

Friday 4th

Fine weather all hands employed setting up rigging and repairing, & finished try works.

Saturday 5th

Fine weather, all hands employed on rigging, and secured Mr. Disbarger John Shirley and Charles Brant, (Boatstewards) and put in John Riley and Frank Costa.

Sunday 6th

One watch on liberty

Monday 7th

One watch on liberty and painting ship with the rest of men. & finished Port Side

Tuesday 8th

Employed painting Starboard Side and hoisting off sundries from shore. Disbarged Am. Boston Second Officer C.

Wednesday 9th

Painting and getting sundries from shore ready for sea. Shipped one Officer and four men, Joseph Lemmen Cook ran away.

Thursday 10th

Kept up at daylight and standing to North along the land. at four p.m. land out of sight steering N. wind E.N.E. Shipped on deck and took the anchors well up to bow and calked them

At two p.m. 13.44 Lon 59.50

Cruising in the North Atlantic

Friday March 11th 1870

Light breeze from N.E. and pleasant steering N.W. latter wind came out E. steering N.W. through Islands in sight. the N. point of Dominica bearing N.W. by W. some fifteen miles at sunset. Shortened sail and hoisted two for the night.

at 10 p.m. lat 15.10 lon 60.36

Saturday 12th

Strong breeze from E. kept off at three a.m. N.W. and at two p.m. came to anchor in five fathoms in Dominica. found the Montezuma of Providentia and two other schooners came in to night sent raft ashore.

Sunday 13th

one watch ashore but one boat crew, and can't get them aboard to night

Monday 14th

Broke out Starboard Side of after hold, and careened the ship and penciled copper on the S. side. filled a raft of water and found two of our casks were stolen. Three men (John Nichols John Newcomb and Abram Lykes) who were all white at Barbadoes ran away. Righted the ship at night sent three men ashore to watch the raft

Tuesday 15th

All the schooner left this morning, brought off a raft of water and stowed it in ground on Starboard Side. ~~can't get to get a~~ got a raft of casks ready to go on shore. can't get casks to fit in ground

Wednesday 16th

Sent raft ashore and filled them and got it aboard, broke out port Side of after hold and stowed back eight casks and filled them, took eight barrels potatoes from shore, and secured
