a Spanish vessel from Havana Bound to Spain and sent
letter by her sent up Pih stay

employed in repairing Waist Boat put Leeward and Bow
Boat on the cranes Lat at 2 P.M. 33° 28' N Long 49° 15' W

Pih at 3 P.M. set in Equally took in sail Wind M.W. Stearing
S.W. Lat at 2 P.M. 33° 08' N Long 49° 10' W

This day com With Light Winds and calms at 5 P.M. a Breeze sprung
up from the N.W. Stearing S.W. at 2 P.M. Lat 32° 03' N Long 48° 42' W

This day com With Pleasant Weather Wind N.E. Stearing S.E.

Bent new Main Topsail Lat at 2 P.M. 29° 30' N Long 45° 14' W

Middle Part Light Winds Stearing S.E.

Latter Part Light Winds and calms Broke out Water

Friday 9th

This day com With Light Airs and calms Stearing S.E. ambient
Foretopmast and bent the foremast from the main Lat at 2 P.M.
28° 22' N Long 38° 38' W

Middle Part Calm

Latter Part Light Winds from the N.W. Stearing South

Saturday 10th

This day com With Light Winds from the N.W. Stearing South

Bent foretopmast Sail Lat at 2 P.M. 27° 56' N Long 37° 57' W

Latter Part the same at Work fitting cutting. Sarge

Sunday 11th

This day com With Light Winds from the N.W. Stearing South
Lat at 2 P.M. 25° 54' N Long 37° 06' W

Middle Part Light Winds and pleasant Weather

Monday 12th

This day com With Fine Weather Wind W. Stearing South
Saw several Finbacks Lat at 2 P.M. 24° 58' N Long 36° 36' W

Middle Part Moderate Weather at 2 A.M. set in Equally

Latter Part Breezing on at 12 m under Double reefed main
tugsail

Tuesday 13th

This day com With a Moderate Gale from the S.W. heading to
the Southward Passed two vessels Bound to the N.W. Breeze freshening
at 4 P.M. close reefed maintopsail and took up the lea Boat

Lat at 4 P.M. 23° 55' N Long 34° 23' W Middle Part a Fresh Gale at 4 A.M.

Began to Moderate Set close reefed Foretopmast

Latter Part Moderate Weather Breaking out Fore hold at 12 m finished and
stowed back
