

Barque Mary Frazier on a Whaling Voyage to the Atlantic
Friday 17th of February 1871

This day com with Light Winds from the N.E.
Steering N by W 1 sail in sight finished repairing
Spanker and stowed it below Lat at two P.M. 23° 34' N Long 67° 00' W
Middle Part Moderate Weather
Latter Part Moderate Weather Wind N.E. head
N.N.W.

Saturday 18th
This day com with Moderate Weather heading
N.N.W. Wind gradually increasing at sundown a Strong
Breeze close reefed the Topsails and made all secure
Lat at two P.M. 27° 08' N Long 68° 07' W
Middle Part Strong Breeze
Latter Part the same Wind & Steering North
crew employed in repairing old fore topsail

Sunday 19th
This day com Strong Breeze from the Eastward
Steering N by E. Finished repairing Topsail bent
it and stowed the other one below at sundown took in
sail and luffed to the Wind Lat at two P.M. 28° 12' N Long 68° 44' W
Middle Part Squally
Latter Part Pleasant Weather Wind South
Steering N.W.

Monday 20th
This day com with Moderate Weather at 10 P.M.
came in Squally Wind shifted to N.W. took
in sail at 3 P.M. cleared up again but Blowing
Fresh Lat at two P.M. 29° 02' N Long 69° 05' W
Middle Part Moderate
Latter Part the same with calms Telling Ticks with new
line

Tuesday 21st
This day com with a calm and ~~low~~ Lat at two P.M.
29° 03' N Long 69° 08' W
Middle Part calm
Latter Part the same repairing Fore topsail

Wednesday 22nd February 1871

This day com with Light airs from the Southward Steering
N.W. Finished Repairing Topsail and stowed it Below
Lat at two P.M. 29° 12' N Long 69° 19' W
Middle Part Moderate Weather
Latter Part Light Winds from the S.W. Steering
N by W Sent down Main topgallant sail repaired it
and bent it again

Thursday 23rd
This day com with Light Winds from the S.W. at
1 P.M. had a squall that shifted the Wind to the
N.E. at Sundown took in sail and wore ship heading
N.W. by N Lat at two P.M. 30° 08' N Long 69° 35' W
Middle Part Fresh Breeze
Latter Part Fresh Breeze from the Eastward Steering
N.W.

Friday 24th
This day com with Fresh Breeze from the Eastward
Steering N.W. by N Lat at two P.M. 30° 48' N Long 70° 30' W
Middle Part Moderate Weather
Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the Southward Steering
N.W.

Saturday 25th
This day com with Light Winds from the
Southward Steering N.W. at Sundown
took in sail and luffed to the Wind head
West Lat at two P.M. 32° 12' N Long 71° 44' W
Middle Part Moderate Weather
Latter Part Moderate Weather heading N.W.
several Sails in sight

Sunday 26th
This day com with Moderate Weather Wind S.W.
heading N.W. 1 Steamer & two Ships in sight
at Sundown took in sail and wore to the Southward
Lat at two P.M. 32° 58' N Long 73° 09' W
Middle Part Moderate
Latter Part Strong Breeze and Squally from
the S.W. heading S.E.

at sundown took in sail

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
