Friday Nov 24th 18
Begins with strong breeze from S.W. with good weather. Ship under all sail steering S.E. Middle & latter parts, wind moderate, from same quarter, course S.E. by S.

Saturday Nov 25th 19
This day begins with light breeze from N.W. with fine weather, ship under all sail steering S.E. by S. Middle & latter parts, good breeze from same quarter. Course the same.

Sunday Nov 26th 20
Begins with strong breeze from North with fair weather. Ship under all sail steering S.E. by S. Middle & latter parts, wind the same.

Monday Nov 27th 21
Begins with air from N.E. with fine weather. Ship under all sail steering S.E. by S. Middle part calm. Latter part, light breeze from S.W. with light squally weather. Course S.E. by S.

Tuesday Nov 28th 22
Begins with good breeze from S.W. with good weather. Ship with all sail set. Steer S.E. by S. One sail in sight bearing South. Middle & latter parts, strong S.W. winds & fair weather.
Course S.S.E. Long 27:31

Wednesday Nov 29th 23
This day begins with strong S.W. winds & good weather. Ship under all sail, steering S.S.E. Passed a Bark steering same course. Middle part wind the same. Latter part light breeze from West with rain squalls.

Thursday Nov 30th 24
Begins with light breeze from S.W. with squally weather. Ship under all sail steering S by E Middle part. Near by Calm, with heavy showers of rain. Latter part light breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather. Course S. by E.

Friday Dec 1st 25
Begins with light breeze from N.E. with fine weather. Ship under all sail steering S by E Middle & latter parts, light breeze from North with fine weather. Lat 24:59 Long 24:13

Saturday Dec 2nd 26
Begins with light winds from North, with fine weather. Ship under all sail. Steering South. Middle & latter parts, wind the same. With squally weather. Got 10 A.M. Spoke the Bark Ocean Stead of New Bedford, 19 months from home with 5,000 sperm.

Sunday Dec 3rd 27
Begins with good breeze from N.E. with fair weather. Ship under all drawing sail steering S.W. by S. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. Two sails in sight

Monday Dec 4th 28
Begins with moderate Trades from N.E. with fine weather. Ship under all sail. Steering S.W. by S. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same.
Latitude 18:56 Longitude 24:36

Tuesday Dec 5th 29
Begins with strong Trades and squally weather. Ship under all sail steering S.W. by S. Middle & latter parts wind the same with good weather yesterday shaped our course for the N.E. end of St Antonio but at day light No land in sight. At 9 A.M. saw the land bearing S by E, showing our chronometer to be at least 40 miles out of the way
