Wednesday Dec 6th 30
Begins with Calm. Ship 12 miles from
the Land, St Antonio bearing S.E. Bk Ocean
stood close to. Middle part. At 11 P.M. took the
Traicer & steered up S by E to make the Land
of St Lago. Latter part. Baffling Wind & thick
Rainy Weather. Ship heading from S by W. to S.E.
At 10 A.M. saw the Island of Fogo bearing S.E.

Thursday Dec 7th 31
Begins with light baffling Wind & thick Rainy
Weather Ship under all sail working up to St Lago
Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same
have up going to St Lago and stood off on the
S.W. tack No Obs

Friday Dec 8th 32
Begins with light Trades & Weather Clearing
Saw the Island of Brava bearing S by E. distant
20 miles. Steered off for it, intending to stop
there tomorrow. Middle part, light trades & good
Weather. Ship Laying off & on at Brava. Latter part
At 7 A.M. the Capt went on shore with two Boats, to
Trade. No Ends

Saturday Dec 9th 33
Begins with fresh Trades & good Weather. Ship
off & on at Brava, trading. At 5 P.M. finished
trading, and came on Board. Kept off, steering
S.W. Middle part light baffling Winds. With good
Weather. Latter part, fresh breeze from East. and
Squally. Steering South with all sail set.
No Obs

Sunday Dec 10th 34
Begins with good breeze from East. With
Squally Weather. Ship under all sail
steering South. Middle part Wind the same
with Clear Weather. Latter part Wind & Weather
the same

Remarks on Board
This day com, with fresh Trades and
good Weather. Ship under all sail. Steering South
by Compass. Middle & Latter parts Wind. Weather
& Course the same. All Hands Employed Breaking
out the After Hold & Coopering Provision
Lat 8. 35 N. Long 23:31 West

Tuesday Dec 12th 36
Begins with strong Trade Wind & fair Weather
at sunset lightning seen in the Southern Horizon
Middle part, Reduced Sail to double reefed topsails
Heavy Tempest all Night with copious rain,
Latter part, Weather clearing, with light airs
and Baffling Lat 7-76 Long 23:13

Wednesday Dec 13th 37
This day begins with light baffling Winds
and Cloudy Weather, Course S by E. Middle &
Latter parts Wind the same, with plenty of Rain
No Obs

Thursday Dec 14th 38
Begins with light airs & Calm, Sunshine
& Showers. Working through the doldrums
Latter part No Rain. Employed Breaking out to
Cooper Lat 5.23 Long 24:10

Friday Dec 15th 39
Begins with light airs & variable with
frequent Showers of Rain. Course S by E
Middle & Latter parts the same
Lat 5-00 N Long 23:54

Saturday Dec 16th 40
Begins with light breeze from North with good
Weather Course S by E. Middle part. Calm & Rainy
until one A.M. then good breeze from North
Latter part Calm with good Weather
Six sails in sight, all bound South
Lat 3:45 North
