Begins with moderate breeze from E. P. E.
With good weather Ship Cruising At 2 P.M.
Lowered for a Right Whale but did not
strike At sunset shortened sail for the Night
Middle & Latter parts Moderate breeze from
N.E. With thick rainy weather Emp Stowing
oil & starting fresh water Lat 37° 50' Long 27° 30'

Saturday Jan 20th 75

Begins with Malin N.E. Wind & thick
Weather, Cruising, At dusk finished
stowing the oil the Whales Making 177
Barrels, Middle part Wind & Weather the
same Latter part Wind the same With
rainy Weather Lat 38° 12' Long 26° 00'

Sunday Jan 21st 76

Begins with strong E. Wind & Riding
Weather Steering S.W. Looking for Whales
Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same

Monday Jan 22nd 77

Begins with Moderate breeze from North
With thick foggy weather & steady rain
Steering to the South Cruising, Middle part
same Latter part good breeze from S.W.
With fair weather Lat 41.00 Long 26° 08'

Tuesday Jan 23rd 78

Begins with good breeze from S.W. With fair
Weather Cruising. At sunset shortened
sail for the Night Middle part Wind the
same Latter part strong breeze from S.W.
With heavy swell on Lat 41:36 Long 25.05

Wednesday Jan 24th 79

Begins with Wind moderating to Calm With
heavy swell Saw several Right Whales going
quick to South, Lowered twice without
success. Middle part, At 9 P.M. breeze springing

up from East, which by daylight increased
to a Gale, Hove the Ship too Under close reefed
Main topsail & stay sails So Ends

Thursday Jan 25th 80

Begins with fresh Gale from East. With
heavy sea. Wind hauling to Northward. Middle
part Wind North with heavy squalls & falling
Barometer. At 11 P.M. Furlled the Main topsail
Latter part Wind hauled to West & moderated
Made some sail & bore Ship to S.W.
Lat 41:45 Long 25:16

Friday Jan 26th 81

Begins with Moderate Gale from West
With Clear Weather. Ship Under Storm
sail heading S.W. Middle & Latter part
Wind & Weather the same Lat 42:36

Saturday Jan 27th 82

Begins with Moderate Gale from West
With thick weather Ship Under short
sail on the Southern tack. Middle part
the Wind hauled to North with rugged
Weather Latter part same. Made some sail
heading to Westward Lat 43:03 Long 25:18

Sunday Jan 28th 83

Begins with strong Wind, from North
With thick rugged weather Ship Under
reefed topsails & Courses, standing to West
ward. At sunset shortened sail for the Night
Middle & Latter parts Moderate Gale from
North & Rainy Weather

Monday Jan 29th 84

Begins with Moderate Gale from North With
Plenty of Rain Middle part same Latter part
Wind hauled to West, With heavy squalls Ship
Hove too Under Storm sail heading N.N.W
