Begins with Gale from N with Rainy weather Ship Hove to on the Eastern tack At 3 P.M. the Wind Moderated and hauled to S.W. Made some sail and kept off steering E.S.E. Middle & Latter parts strong Wind from South and Rugged. Ship Under Topsails & Courses, steering E.S.E. Lat 38 29 Long 38:00

Friday March 1st 116

Begins with strong southerly Wind and Rugged weather. Ship Under Topsails and Courses steering E.S.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind the same and increasing, took in fifth & Mainsail. Course the same

Saturday March 2nd 117

Begins with Moderate Gale from South and heavy Sea, with thick weather, at dark too Rugged to run, Hove to Under Storm sail, heading E.S.E. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate, Wind S.W. Made some sail, and kept off S.E. by E. No Obs

Sunday March 3rd 118

Begins with strong Windy from S.W. with Clear weather, steering S.E. by E. Under Top sails & Courses, Middle & Latter parts fine breeze W.S.W. with good weather Ship Under all sail Latitude 37:54 Long 46:34 East

Monday March 4th 119

Begins with fine breeze from W.S.W. with good weather. Ship Under all sail steering S.E. by E. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from S.W. with fine weather, Course the same A Very fine day

Tuesday March 5th 120

This day begins with light breeze from S.W. with fine Pleasant weather, Ship Under all sail steering S.E. by E. Middle part, the Wind hauled to E.S.E. Latter part the same with fine weather. Lat 38:15 Long 48:55

Wednesday Mar 6th 121

Begins with light Wind from E.S.E. with fine Pleasant weather. Ship Under all sail heading S.E. One sail in sight on the same tack, Middle & Latter parts Wind light from N.E. and good weather. Lat 39:11 Long 52:32

Thursday March 7th 122

Begins with light Wind from N.E. with fine weather. Ship Under all sail heading E.S.E. Middle & Latter parts, Moderate Wind from North to N.W. with good weather Long 55:54

Friday March 8th 123

Begins with good breeze from West to S.W. with Cloudy weather. Ship Under all sail, steering E.S.E. Middle & Latter parts, light baffling Wind from S.W. to S.S.W. with fine weather So Ends Lat 38:45 Long 59:18

Saturday March 9th 124

This day begins with light breeze from S.W. with fine Pleasant weather. Ship with all sail out steering E.S.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same

Sunday March 10th 125

Begins with light breeze from West with fine Pleasant weather. Ship Under all sail steering S.E. by E. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same, Spoke the English Ship Ganges of, and 60 days from Liverpool, Bound to Calcutta
