Begins with light airs from S.E. with fine weather Ship of 4 on at Amsterdam Island At 5 P.M. the Boats returned with a good catch, Middle part Calm, the Watch busy cleaning & salting fish, latter part light airs from West, with fine weather, from our catch of fish, we have salted, sixteen Barrels, So Ends

Friday March 22nd 137

Begins with light airs from West, with fine pleasant weather, Ship Under all sail steering East by South, Middle & latter parts moderate breeze from N.W. with good weather. Course the same.

Saturday March 23rd 138

Begins with moderate breeze from N.W. with good weather, Ship Under all sail steering E by S Middle & latter parts strong breeze from W.N.W. with good weather, Lat 37 26 Long 84:24 East

Sunday March 24th 139

Begins with strong breeze from N.W. with fair weather, Ship Under all sail steering East by S, Middle part, the wind hauled to South, with strong breeze & squally weather, took in light sails and reefed the topsails, latter part the same

Monday March 25th 140

Begins with strong breeze from South with clear weather, Ship Under Topsails & Courses, steering E by S, Middle & latter parts good breeze from S.E. with cloudy weather, made all sail steering by to N.E. Repacked our fish and stowed them away So Ends

Tuesday March 26th 141

This day begins with good breeze from S.E. with cloudy weather, Ship Under all sail by the wind to N.E. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same.

Lat 33:47 Long 90:36

Wednesday March 27th 142

Begins with with strong S.E. winds & cloudy weather, Ship Under all sail heading to the N.E. At dark wore Ship to S.W. Middle part wind the same, latter part light breeze from N.E. with good weather Lat 33:55

Thursday March 28th 143

Begins with light breeze from N.E. with good weather, Ship Under all sail heading E.S.E. This afternoon, saw 13 blackfish, lowered and got, one to the Bow Boat, Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same

Lat 34:20 Long 93:36

Friday March 29th 144

Begins with strong breeze from North with cloudy weather, Course E by South, At 5 P.M. the wind hauled suddenly to South with Rainy weather, Middle & latter parts strong winds from South and squally, Course the same

Saturday March 30th 145

Begins with strong Southerly winds & squally weather, Ship Under Topsails & Courses, by the wind to East, Middle & latter parts the same

Sunday March 31st 146

Begins with strong winds from S.P.E. with cloudy Bugged weather, Ship Under all sail heading E by N, Middle & latter parts wind the same with better weather
