Tuesday April 2nd 148
Begins with moderate breeze from S.E. with
occasional squalls of Rain Ship with all
sail out heading East. Middle part. Calm
Latter part, Wind from same old quarter

Wednesday April 3th 149
Begins with strong breeze from S.E. with
squally weather. Ship under all sail heading
E.N.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather
the same

Thursday April 4th 150
Begins with strong S.E. winds & rugged
weather Ship under all sail heading E.S.E.
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather same
Lat 28:28 Long 105:45

Friday April 5th 151
Begins with strong S.E. winds & rugged
weather. steering by the wind to E.S.E.
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same

Saturday April 6th 152
Begins with strong winds from South to S.E.
with rugged weather. Ship under 10 sails
& courses heading East. At dark shortened
sail for the night. Middle & Latter parts
Wind more moderate from same quarter
Ship on different tack Cruising

Sunday April 7th 153
Begins with moderate Wind from S.P.E.
with good Whaling weather. Ship under
all sail Cruising. Middle & Latter parts, Wind
and weather the same No Obs

Monday April 8th 154
Begins with good breeze from S.P.E. with fair
weather Ship under all sail, on the Eastern
tack, Cruising. Saw a Steamer, Bound N.W.
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same
At 11 A.M. saw Two Sperm Whales, going quick
to Windward Lat 27:39 Long 109:37

Tuesday April 9th 155
Begins with smart breeze from S.E. and good
weather Ship under all sail, beating to Windward
for the Whales, At sunset the Whales were on the
Weather Beam, Four miles distant, They are
the first Sperm Whales we have seen since
leaving Home, and no chance to get one.
Middle & Latter parts moderate breeze from S.E.
with fine weather Ship under all sail, beating
to Windward. Lat 27 45 Long 110:08

Wednesday April 10th 156
Begins with moderate breeze from S.E. with
fine pleasant weather. Ship under all sail
Cruising. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather
the same Lat 27 27 Long 109:40

Thursday April 11th 157
Begins with good breeze from S.E. with good
weather. Ship under all sail Cruising. Spoke
the Bk Lancer, Macy, of New Bedford, three
years out, with 14.00 Sperm. Middle & Latter
parts. Strong winds & rugged weather
