rugged, with clear weather. Ship under all
sail Cruising Middle & Latter parts Wind
& Weather the same. Ship standing to the S.W.
Lat 28:18

Saturday April 13th 159
Begins with moderate breeze from S.E.
With fine pleasant weather. Ship with
all sail out steering by to S.S.W. Middle
and Latter parts Wind & Weather the same
Lat 29 - 28 Long 109:36

Sunday April 14th 160
Begins with moderate breeze from S.E. with
good weather. Ship under all sail steering
S by W. Middle part Wind the same
Latter part light breeze from S.E.
Lat 30:18

Monday April 15th 161
Begins with light breeze from S.E. with
good weather. Ship under all sail, heading
S.W. At sunset tacked to E.S.E. Middle & Latter
parts Wind & Weather the same. At day light
tacked to the S.W.

Tuesday April 16th 162
Begins with fine breeze from S.E. with good
weather. Ship under all sail on the S.W. tack
at 4 P.M. saw Sperm Whales, going to Wind
ward, lowered four Boats and gave Chase
but did not strike. At dark tacked to East
Middle & Latter parts, strong winds from S.W.
Steering in to S.E.
Lat 30:12 Long 109:55

Wednesday April 17th 163
This day begins with strong Wind from
S.W. with good whaling weather. Ship under
all sail heading S.E. At dark shortened sail
Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same
Lat 30:24 Long 111-00

Thursday April 18th 164
Begins with good breeze from S.W. by S. with
fine weather. Ship with all sail set heading
S.E. by S. Middle & Latter parts strong breeze
from W.S.W. with good weather. Heading S.
Lat 30.46 Long 112:08

Friday April 19th 165
Begins with strong breeze from S.W. with
squally weather. Ship under all sail
heading S.E. At dark took light sails
and tacked Ship to West. Middle & Latter
parts Moderate Gale from S.S.E. & Rugged
with squally weather Lat 31:15

Saturday April 20th 166
Begins with Moderate Gale from S.S.E. with
squally rugged weather. Ship under all
sails reefed Top sails & Courses, heading
S.W. Middle part Wind more Moderately, Latter
part Calm. Lat 33:06 Long 109:45

Sunday April 21st 167
Begins with Rapid strong from West, with
good weather. Ship under all sail steering
S.E. by S. Middle part Wind increased to a
Moderate Gale & hauled to South. Latter part
Wind & Weather the same. Ship heading
E.S.E. under Reefed Top sails & Reef sails
So Ends No Ob
