This day begins with strong breeze from
N.E. with good Whaling weather. Ship under
all sail Cruising. At dark shortened sail.
Middle & Latter parts Wind strong from
N.E. and Rugged Ship standing to N.E.

Sunday May 26th 202
Begins with strong winds from N.E. with
Rugged weather Ship under Top sails & Courses
Cruising Middle & Latter parts good breeze from
W.N.W. with good weather Lat 35.26 Long 123.33

Monday May 27th 203
Begins with fine breeze from W.N.W. with good
weather. Ship under all sail Cruising
Middle & Latter parts light variable winds and
Rainy weather Lat 35.16 Long 124.20

Tuesday May 28th 204
Begins with Moderate breeze from S.W. with
weather clearing, Made all sail, at 5 P.M.
Spoke the 13th Canton of New Bedford, Latham
Master, Nineteen Months from Home, with 150
lbs. Sperm. Middle & Latter parts strong Wind
from S.W. and Rugged

Wednesday May 29th 205
This day begins with strong S.W. Wind and
Rugged weather Ship under Top sails & Courses
heading W.N.W. The Canton in sight at dark
shortened sail & wore to S.E. Middle part Wind
died out to Calm. Latter part light air from N.E.
with Pleasant weather. At 10 A.M. saw Sperm
Whaler 5 miles off. Lowered four Boats in chase
So Ends

Thursday May 30th 206
Begins with light air from N.E. with Pleasant
weather Four Boats in chase of Sperm Whaler, after
chasing until sunset, came on Board without
success. 13th Canton in company, Southeast
Island in sight, 10 miles distant, bearing W.S.W.
Middle & Latter parts. Strong breeze from N.E.
Cruising

Friday May 31st 207
Begins with strong breeze from N.E. with Rugged
weather. Ship under all sail. Cruising. Spoke
13th Ellenmaid, of Westport, Moran, Master, 28
Months from Home, with 700 Sperm. Middle part
Wind the same with Rainy weather. Latter part Wind
hauling to S.W. Moderate Gale & Rainy So Ends

Saturday June 1st 208
Begins with Moderate Gale from S.W. with Rugged
Rainy weather. Ship under Reefed Top sails & Stay
sails, on the Port Tack. Middle & Latter parts
Wind the same with heavy Squalls of Rain
& Hail. Ship Hove too on Port Tack

Sunday June 2nd 209
Begins with Gale from S.W. with heavy Squalls
with Rain & Hail. Ship Hove too under Close Reefed
Main Top sail & Stay sails. heading West, at dark
wore Ship to S.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind and
Weather the same Lat 35.05

Monday June 3rd 210
Begins with Gale from S.W. with squally Rugged
weather Ship Hove too under Storm Sail, on
different tacks. Middle part Wind & Weather
the same. Latter part rather more Moderate
with heavy swell running. Made some sail
standing to N.W. Two Sails in sight
So Ends
