Monday June 24th 231
Begins with Gale from West with heavy Squalls and heavy Sea. Ship Hove to Under Storm Stay sails and part of clew reefed Main Top sail, on the Southern tack. This is the tenth day of a succession of heavy Gales, Middle & Latter parts Wind more moderate, with clear weather

Tuesday June 25th 232
Begins with moderate Gale from West with clear weather, Wind gradually moderating, set the Fore Top sail, Clew reefed Ship on the Northern tack, Middle part, the Wind hauled to North with strong breeze, Latter part Wind the same Ship Under Top sails & Fore sail, Cloudy weather

Wednesday June 26th 233
Begins with strong Wind from N.N.W. with rugged weather & Cloudy. Ship Under Top sails & Fore course heading West. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same.

Thursday June 27th 234
Begins with moderate Gale from North with thick stormy weather. At dark the Wind hauled to West and cleared up. Wore Ship to N.W. Middle & Latter parts fresh Gale from North West, Ship Hove to Under Storm Sail heading N.N.E.

Friday June 28th 235
Begins with fresh Gale from N.W. and Squally. Ship Hove to heading W.S.W. Middle part same Latter part Wind hauled to N.S.W. and abated some set double reefed Top sails & Courses & wore to N.W. Weather clear, & rugged Sea

Saturday June 29th 236
Begins with strong Winds from N.S.W. with rugged weather, Ship Under reefed Top sails & Courses, heading N.S.W. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same, Lat 35:10 Long 24:10

Sunday June 30th 237
Begins with moderate Gale from N.S.W. & Squally. Ship Under reefed Main Top sail & Fore course heading N.W. At sun set wore Ship to South Middle & Latter parts Wind rather more moderate and steady, set reefed Top sails & Courses, heading N.N.W.

Monday July 1st 238
Begins with strong Winds from West, with rugged weather, Cruising, Saw two Whalers to Leeward, at 4 P.M. Southeast Island bearing N.W. 30 miles distant. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from West with good weather

Tuesday July 2nd 239
Begins with light breeze from West, with fine pleasant weather Ship Under all sail Cruising, Three sails in sight, Middle part Calm, Latter part light air, and baffling, with thick Rainy weather No Obs

Wednesday July 3rd 240
Begins with light baffling Winds and Rainy weather with Fog Middle & Latter parts, good breeze from North with good weather, Cruising

Thursday July 4th 241
Begins with good breeze from North with fine weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Bent new Jib & Mizzen Stay sail, Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same Spoke Bank Calls of New Bedford.
