Wednesday July 24th 261
Begins with heavy Gale from W.N.W. with
heavy squalls. The wind in the squalls blowing
nearly a Hurricane. At 3 P.M. the fore part of
the Main Toppail, parted, and before it could be
clewed up, the sail was badly damaged. Middle
part, Gale abated some, and the squalls not so
violent. Latter part Moderate Gale from same
quarter, and still squally. Sent down the Main
Toppail to repair, and made some temporary repairs
on the starboard side Lat 36:57 Long 124:02

Thursday July 25th 262
Begins with Gale abating fast & sea going down
Bent the Main Toppail, and wore ship to
North. Middle & Latter parts, strong winds from
W.S.W. and squally. Steered of E.S.E. Under
reefed Toppails & Foresail

Friday July 26th 263
Begins with strong winds from W.S.W. with
squally weather. Ship under reefed Top
sails & Foresail & jib steering E.S.E. At dark
shortened sail & wore ship to N.W. Middle
& Latter parts, Moderate winds from S.W. with
fair weather made all sail and steered off
East

Saturday July 27th 264
Begins with Moderate breeze from West
with fair weather. Ship under all sail steering
East. Employed making some temporary
bulwarks and ready to put out some boats.
Middle & Latter parts fresh breeze from West
with fair weather. Course the same
Lat 37:15 Long 128:58

Sunday July 28th 265
Begins with fresh breeze from West with
good weather. Ship under all sail steering
East. Middle & Latter parts strong winds from
W.S.W. with squally weather. Course E.S.E.

Monday July 29th 266
Begins with strong winds from W.S.W. with
squally weather steering S.E. Under Toppails
& Main sails. Middle part wind the same latter
part light breeze from same quarter with light
squalls of rain. Lat 38:00 Long 135:30

Tuesday July 30th 267
Begins calm with showers weather. Course
S.E. Middle part light breeze from S.W. latter
part strong breeze from S.W. and squally weather.
Ship under all sail steering S.E.
Lat 39:15 Long 136:20

Wednesday July 31st 268
Begins with strong winds from S.W. by W.
with squally weather. Ship under reefed Top
sails, Main sails & jib steering S.E. Middle & Latter
parts wind more moderate from West with
clear weather. Ship under all sail. Course
the same. Lat 40:55 Long 138:40

Thursday Aug 1st 269
Begins with good breeze from W.N.W. with good
weather. Ship under all sail steering S.E. by S.
Employed repairing chain. Course Middle
part, wind hauled to S.W. and increased to a
Moderate Gale. Latter part fresh Gale from S.W.
with heavy squalls of hail. Ship under close
reefed chain Toppail & Fore. Course steering
S.E. by E Lat 43:15 Long 140:39
