to fourteen days imprisonment with Hard Labor, at the
Police Court to day. Crew all busy at Work

Tuesday Aug 13th 281
Good weather all day, Carpenters at Work Crew Emp
at various Jobs last Night. David Roberts Green Hand
absented himself without leave supposed deserted
at Night, Crew went on Liberty for 12 Hours

Wednesday Aug 14th 282
Good weather all day Carpenters at Work, this Morning
Crew all returned and are busy at Work at Night on
Liberty

Thursday Aug 15th 283
Good weather, Carpenters all Work, Crew all busy
Cook, setting up Shocks for after Hold at Night on Liberty

Friday Aug 16th Same Saturday Aug 17th Same 284
Sunday Aug 18th Crew on Liberty for twenty four Hours 284

Monday Aug 19th 285
Good weather all day Carpenters at Work, commenced
breaking out Main Hold, to Pump Oil to Sell, this Morning
Crew all returned

Tuesday Aug 20th Same Wednesday Aug 21st Same 286

Thursday Aug 22nd 287
Good weather Carpenters at Work, Crew all busy, Breaching
out after Hold & Stowing Water, George Green, Green Hand
fell down the Fore Hold, to day, sent him to the Hospital
for treatment Joseph Frater & Christian Edlipson, on Missing
this Morning, supposed deserted

Friday Aug 23rd 291
Fore Noon Good weather, after noon Raining, Carpenters at
Work, Crew all busy, Manuel Vincent, & Manuel George
Missing this Morning, supposed deserted, George Green
was returned from the Hospital, all right, and went to Work

Saturday Aug 24th 292
Good weather all day, Carpenters at Work, got all our Water
on board, got everything off the Wharf, and at 5 PM hailed
a Steamer, and was towed into the Stream, came to with
best anchor & 60 fathoms of Chain

Sunday Aug 25th 293
Good weather, Crew on board Liberty played out

Monday Aug 26th 294
Cloudy weather, Two Carpenters at Work, Crew Emp
clearing the Decks Afternoon Raining Nothing doing

Tuesday Aug 27th 295
Good weather Carpenters finished at Night Crew Emp
Painting the New Work outside & Inside

Wednesday Aug 28th 296
Good weather, Last Night John Payne Cooper & Francisco
Chandle, Seaman, deserted from the Ship by Swimming
on Shore

Thursday Aug 29th 297
Good weather, to day took on board our Potatoes and
other recruits. Ship ready for Sea, Waiting for Men
Five Men came on board, Shipped at this Port

Friday Aug 30th 298
Rainy weather, Nothing doing

Saturday Aug 31st 299
Good weather this Morning took the Anchor, and went
down the River, came to about 5 miles from Town, to
wait for the Capt, came to with best anchor & 50 fathoms
of Chain
