Sunday Sept 1st

300

Begins with fine weather with light breeze from different quarters Ship at anchor, below Hobart Town with Officers & Crew on Board.

Monday Sept 2nd

301

Begins with fine weather. Ship at anchor below Hobart Town waiting for Capt. & some Men. Last Night Manuel Gomez & Joseph Sison, attempted to desert from the Ship by Swimming, but were discovered. & brought back to the Ship, we are laying about two Miles from Shore

Tuesday Sept 3rd

302

To day strong winds from N.E. Ship at anchor at 10 AM. Boat came from Town, bringing two New Men and two deserters, David Roberts & Francisco Chamelle and this afternoon came again bringing the Cooper. John Payne, The Capt thinks he will get away tomorrow

Wednesday Sept 4th

303

To day, Calm all day, this afternoon the Capt came on board, New Short, but there was no wind at dark Pazed out Chain to Lay untill Morning

Thursday Sept 5th

304

Begins with light gale and baffling, at day light got Underweigh to work out to Sea at 12 M was just abreast of the Iron Post Light so Ends with 12 hours Civil Time

Friday Sept 6th

305

Begins with fresh breeze from N.W. with cloudy weather, & some rain, at dark was all clear of the land, with anchors Stowed, Chains below and everything snug, Ship heading N.E. by E. Middle part, the wind hauled to S.W. and increased to Moderate Gale, put the Ship Under reefed Topsails & Fore Course, Steering N.E. latter part, fresh Gale from South, hauled the Fore topsail. Steering North

Saturday Sept 7th

306

Begins with Moderate Gale from South, with squally weather, Ship Under reefed Main Top sail & Fore sail, Steering N.E. at dark Moon Moderate, Set the Fore topsail, double reefed, Middle & latter parts, strong breeze from N.W. with cloudy weather Steering by the wind to N.E.

Sunday Sept 8th

307

Begins with strong breeze from W.N.W. with cloudy weather, Ship Under Topsails & Courses by the wind, heading North. Middle & latter parts Under & weather the same  
Lat 38:00 Long 153:00

Monday Sept 9th

308

Begins with good breeze from W.N.W. with good weather Ship Under all sail heading North. At sunset Shortened sail, Middle & latter parts light breeze from N.N.W. with fine weather Ship Under all sail, Cruising

Tuesday Sept 10th

309

Begins with light breeze from N.N.W. with fine pleasant weather, Ship Under all sail Cruising Middle part Under the same latter part strong breeze from N.N.W. with good weather. Lat 36:50 Long 154:55

Wednesday Sept 11th

310

Begins with strong breeze from N.N.W. with good weather Ship Under all sail heading West. At dark shortened sail, Saw plenty of Finback Whales & Right Whale Biscs, Middle part Under increased to Moderate Gale from N.N.W. and huzzed Ship Under reefed Topsails & Stay sails
