Monday Sept 23th

322

Begins With Moderate Gale from S.W. With Clear Weather Ship Under Steam Sail heading N.N.W. Middle part Wind Moderated to strong breeze, latter part same. At day light made all sail & steered off North

Tuesday Sept 24th

323

Begins With strong breeze from S.W. With fair weather, Ship Under all sail, steering North, at sunset shortened sail & luffed to the wind heading W.N.W. Middle & latter parts Wind & Weather the same

Wednesday Sept 25th

324

Begins With strong breeze from S.W. With clear weather & rugged. Ship Under all sail, Cruising. Spoke Bk Eliza, of New Bedford Dirrory, Master, 37 months from home, with 1700 bbls oil. Middle & latter parts, Wind the same, with squally weather Lat 35:20

Thursday Sept 26th

325

Begins With strong S.W. winds & squally weather Ship Under reefed topsails & courses, Cruising Middle & latter parts Wind & weather the same Lat 34:20 Long 154:30

Friday Sept 27th

326

Begins With strong S.W. winds & squally weather Ship Under reefed topsails & courses. We find a strong Northwesterly Current here, One Whaler in sight Middle & latter parts same

Saturday Sept 28th

327

Begins With strong winds from S.E. & with rugged weather. Middle part the Wind died out to Calm, with heavy swell latter part Calm with fine weather

Sunday Sept 29th

328

Begins Calm, with fine weather, at sunset, light breeze from S.E. Steering South, Middle part fresh breeze from North latter part Moderate Gale from North, with thick rainy weather. Ship Under Short sail, steering South No Obs

Monday Sept 30th

329

Begins With Moderate Gale from North with plenty of rain, steering South at dark, the Wind hauled to West, weather clearing, some, Middle part, Moderate Gale from S.W. latter part Heavy Gale from S.W. with heavy squalls & dangerous sea, Ship Hove to heading W.N.W. at 8 a.m. Split the Fore Topmast Stay sail

Tuesday Oct 1st

330

Begins With Heavy Gale from S.W. With heavy squalls & dangerous sea running. Ship Hove to on the port tack, Under close reefed Main Top sail & Mizzen Stay sail, heading W.N.W. Middle part Gale Moderated to strong breeze With rugged weather, latter part the same Lat 36:51 Long 155:55

Wednesday Oct 2nd

331

Begins With strong breeze from S.W. With good weather, but rugged. Ship Under Topsails & courses, steering S.E. Middle & latter parts Moderate breeze from West with good weather Cruising

Thursday Oct 3rd

332

Begins With good breeze from N.W. With good weather Ship Under all sail Middle part Wind the same with rainy weather latter part Moderate breeze from North, steering S.W. Lat 37:40 Long 154:22
