333

Begins with Moderate breeze from N.E. With fair weather. Ship under all sail Steaming S.W. At dark shortened sail. Middle part Wind hauled to S.E. and increased to a Moderate Gale, with Rain. Latter part heavy Gale from S.E. Ship Hove to heading East

Saturday, Oct 5th

334

Begins with heavy Gale from S.E. With heavy Sea Ship Hove to Under Span Sail. Middle part same Latter part more Moderate Made some Sail & Run Ship S.W.

Sunday, Oct 6th

335

Begins with Moderate Gale from S.E. With squally weather Ship Under Reefed Topsails & Flaysails heaving S.W. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from S.E. With fine weather Lat 37:30 Long 154:00

Monday, Oct 7th

336

Begins with light breeze from S.E. With fine weather Ship under all sail Cruising Middle part same. Latter part Moderate breeze from S.E. With good weather, Repairing Fore sail.

Tuesday, Oct 8th

337

Begins with strong Wind from N.E. With cloudy weather Ship under all sail Cruising Middle & Latter parts Under & weather the same Lat 38:29 Long 152:20

Wednesday, Oct 9th

338

Begins with strong N.E. winds & cloudy weather Ship under Reefed Topsails Cruising Middle part the same Latter part strong Wind from North, with Plenty of Rain So Ends

Thursday, Oct 10th

339

Begins Calm, with thick Fog, Middle part the same Latter part Moderate breeze from S.W. With cloudy weather. Ship under all sail Cruising. To day discovered that the Cutwater of the Ship, was started off nearly an Inch causing the Ship to make some water, done by a heavy sea, striking on the Bow during the Gale, on the first of this month, went at work, & Caulked & Battened, & Covered it with Lead & Copper. No Ob.

Friday, Oct 11th

340

Begins with Moderate breeze from S.E. With cloudy weather. Ship under all sail Cruising At dark nearly Calm, Middle part Calm Latter part Moderate breeze from N.E. With thick weather Lat 39:19 Long 153:43

Saturday, Oct 12th

341

Begins with strong breeze from North, with thick cloudy weather. Ship under all sail Cruising. Middle & Latter parts, Moderate breeze from same quarter, with Rainy weather

Sunday, Oct 13th

342

Begins nearly Calm, with thick foggy weather, Ship under short sail. Middle part Calm Latter part good breeze from N.E. With fair weather. Ship under all sail Steaming N.W. by W

Monday, Oct 14th

343

Begins with strong breeze from N.E. With thick foggy weather, Ship under all sail Steaming N.W. At dark bore Ship & shortened sail. Middle & Latter parts Moderate Wind With thick Rainy weather No Ob.
