Begins with strong breeze from North, with
Hazy weather, Ship Under Topsails and
Fore Course, Boiling, Middle part the
Wind hauled to South, and for several hours
blew a Gale, latter part more moderate
with heavy swell made some sail

Monday Nov 18th

378

Begins with strong breeze from South
with hazy weather Ship Under
Reefed Topsails Boiling Middle &
Latter parts more moderate with good
weather, Finished Boiling So Ends

Tuesday Nov 19th

379

Begins with light breeze from North with
good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising
Spoke Bark & the shells of Hobart Town, Middle
& Latter parts fresh breeze from North with fair
weather Stowed down the Oil, and washed
the Ship Lat 36:30 Long 152:10

Wednesday Nov 20th

380

Begins with fresh breeze from North with fair
weather, Ship Under all sail Cruising.
Middle & Latter parts Wind the same, with
thick cloudy weather So Ends

Thursday Nov 21st

381

Begins with moderate breeze from North
with thick Hazy weather Ship Under all
sail Cruising Middle & Latter parts same

Friday Nov 22nd

382

Begins with strong breeze from NNE with
thick rainy weather Ship Under short
sail, Middle & Latter parts moderate Gale
from N.E. with thick weather

Begins with moderate Gale from N.E. with
thick Hazy weather. Ship Under Reefed
Topsails & Staysails, on the Southern tack
Middle & Latter parts, Wind & weather the same
Lat 37:10 Long 153:05

Sunday Nov 24th

384

Begins with strong N.E. Winds, and Hazy
weather Ship Under Reefed Topsails and
Staysails, Cruising Middle & Latter parts
Wind more moderate from same quarter but
weather still Hazy Lat 37:31 Long 153:02

Monday Nov 25th

385

Begins with Wind & weather the same
Ship Under all sail looking for Whales
Middle & Latter parts same

Lat 36 59 Long 152:20

Tuesday Nov 26th

386

Begins with steady N.E. Winds & Hazy
weather Ship Under Topsails & Courses
Cruising, Middle & Latter parts the same

Wednesday Nov 27th

387

Begins with strong Winds from N.E.
with thick rainy weather Ship Under
Reefed Topsails on different tacks
Middle & Latter parts the same

Thursday Nov 28th

388

Begins with the same old Wind & weather
& Ends with the same

Friday Nov 29th

389

Begins with light air from North
with thick Fog & rain Ship Under short
sail. Middle & Latter parts good breeze from
South with good weather Ship Under all
sail Cruising Lat 37 06 Long 152:35
