Sunday Dec 1st

391

Begins with fine breeze from East, with fine & pleasant weather Ship Under all sail. Spoke Bk Ediga of New Bedford was not taken a whale in the past eight months Middle & Latter parts light breeze from S.E.

Monday Dec 2nd

392

Begins with light breeze from S.E. At 4 P.M. Wind hauled to South & blew on to Moderate Gale Middle & Latter parts same Ship on the Western tack Under Reefed Top sails

Tuesday Dec 3rd

393

Begins with Wind moderating fast Made some sail & bore Ship to the Eastward Middle & Latter parts good breeze from South with cloudy weather Ship Under all sail

Wednesday Dec 4th

394

Begins with good breeze from South with good Whaling weather, Ship Under all sail Cruising Middle & Latter parts strong winds from S.E. with rugged weather

Thursday Dec 5th

395

Begins with strong S.E. winds & rugged with Hazy weather. Ship Under Reefed Top sails & Courses, on the Southern tack. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same

Begins with Wind Moderate from E. With fair weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same Lat 36:47 Long 151:09

Saturday Dec 7th

397

This day begins with Moderate winds from N.E. with Hazy weather, Ship Under all sail steering in for the Land, at sunset bore Ship off Shore Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same, at daylight bore Ship in Shore & Made all sail Saw several Coasters to day

Sunday Dec 8th

398

Begins with good breeze from N.E. with fair weather, Ship Under all sail standing in for the Land, with the Land in sight at 4 P.M. 10 miles from the Land, bore Ship off shore, at 5 P.M. heavy Thunder storm, and the Wind hauled suddenly to South, put the Ship Under close Reef, Middle part rainy weather, not much Wind, Latter part light breeze from S.E. with fine weather

Lat 36:30 S Long 151:40 E.

Monday Dec 9th

Begins with light air from East with fine weather Spoke Bk Metairie off Sydney N.S.W. 14 months out with 2.80 Spinn, Middle & Latter parts Calm

Begins Calm, at 3 P.M. a strong breeze sprung up from South, Made all sail Middle & Latter parts Moderate winds from South with good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising
