

Bark Mary Frazier of New Bedford

Monday Dec 30th 420  
Begins with strong breeze from North with weather threatening. At 3 P.M. took the second Heave to the Gangway, Separated the Junk and while lashing it, the Case tore out and went adrift, lowered two boats to make fast to it. Haulid it along side and found that the oil had all run out, so cut it adrift. Middle part, strong wind from North & rugged. Latter part Gale from North with plenty of rain.

Tuesday Dec 31st 421  
Begins with Gale from North & rainy weather. At 2 P.M. wind hauled to S.W. blowing a Gale and Pouring Rain Storm for three hours after which time moderated to strong breeze and clear weather. Emp. Boiling as fast as possible. Middle & Latter parts Wind the same, and very rugged. Lat 36:38 Long 157:40

Wednesday Jan 1st 422  
Begins with strong fresh S.W. sail winds from S.W. with clear weather, and rugged, Employed Boiling, and Stowed some Oil. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same.

Thursday Jan 2nd 423  
Begins with strong winds from S.W. with fair weather. Emp. Boiling & Stowed some Oil. Middle part Wind hauled to N.E. & Moderated to light breeze. Latter part Calm.

Friday Jan 3rd 423  
Begins Calm with good weather. At 2 P.M. Finished Boiling. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from S.W. with good weather. Employed Stowing Oil.

Saturday Jan 4th 425  
Begins with light breeze from S.W. with fine weather. Ship under all sail Cruising. At 4 P.M. Finished Stowing down, the two Whales making 160 Barrels. Spoke the Bk. Water Witch of Hobart Town. Middle & Latter parts good breeze from S.W. with good weather. Lat 36:10 Long 157:01

Sunday Jan 5th 426  
Begins with good breeze from S.E. with fair weather. Ship under all sail steering off N.W. Nine different sail in sight to day. This afternoon spoke the Ship, Emma C. Jones, Gifford Master 19 months out with 600 Sperm. Middle & Latter parts, Strong winds from same quarter with clear weather.

Monday Jan 6th 427  
Begins with strong S.E. winds & clear weather. Ship under top sails & courses, Cruising. Middle & Latter parts Moderate breeze from East with fine weather. Three sails in sight to day. Lat 34:20 Long 158:15

Tuesday Jan 7th 428  
Begins with moderate breeze from East with fine pleasant weather. Ship under all sail, Cruising. Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same.

Wednesday Jan 8th 429  
Begins with fresh breeze from East with good weather. Ship under all sail heading to the S.W. Middle & Latter parts fresh breeze from East with cloudy weather and some rain. So Ends
