Sunday Jan 19th 440
Begins with Moderate breeze from S.E. with
good weather Ship Under all sail, Cruising
Middle part, Calm, Latter part light airs
from S.W. with fine weather, at Nine o'clk.
Lowered Four Boats in Chase of Spinn
Whales Lat 34:24 Long 158:34

Monday Jan 20th 441
Begins with Wind & Weather the same
with the boats Chasing to Leeward
at 3 P.M. the Larboard Boat went alongside
of a large Whale, but did not get fast, hauled
the Iron in, and found it went nearly double
Chased the Whale until dark, but did not
get another chance, Middle part Light airs
from S.E. Steering off, Under short sail
Latter part strong breeze from same quarter
Cruising Lat 33:40 Long 159:09

Tuesday Jan 21st 442
Begins with good breeze from S.E. with good
weather. Ship Under all sail, Cruising
one Whaler in sight Middle part the Wind
hauled round to N.W. Latter part strong breeze
from North, Ship Under all sail steering South

Wednesday Jan 22nd 443
Begins with strong breeze from North, with
cloudy weather Steering S.E. Under all sail
Middle part same Latter part Moderate Gale
from North & Rainy Ship Under Reefed Topsails
Course the same No. Obs.

Thursday Jan 23rd 444
Begins with Moderate Gale from North, at
2 P.M. the Wind shifted to S.W. in a heavy Squall
with Torrent of Rain, Thunder and Lightning
at dark strong Wind from West with clear
weather Middle part Moderate Gale from S.W.
Latter part fresh Gale from South & heavy Sea

Friday Jan 24th 445
Begins with Gale from South with Squally
Weather & heavy Sea. Ship Hoisted Under
Cloze Reefed Main Top sail & Staysails to
E.S.E. Middle part the Wind died out to light
breeze Latter part same with good weather
Made all sail Lat 34:31 Long 158:40

Saturday Jan 25th 446
Begins with light breeze from S.E. with good
weather. Spoke 12k Three Brothers of New Bedford
Middle & Latter parts, Calm.

Sunday Jan 26th 447
Begins with light breeze from N.W. with good
weather. Ship Under all sail steering to
the South Two Whalers in sight
Middle part Wind hauled to S.E. with strong
breeze & Rainy weather Latter part Wind
the same, Weather Clear So Ends

Monday Jan 27th 448
Begins with strong S.E. Winds & Rugged
with clear weather. Ship Under Reefed
Top sails & Staysails heading S.W. Middle
& Latter parts Moderate breeze from same
quarter with good weather Made all sail
Cruising Three sails in sight
