Tuesday Feb 25th

477

Begins with light breeze from E.S.E. with fine weather at 2 P.M. got around to the watering place and sent a Raft for Water at 4:30 the Boat came back with the Raft Empty, it being too Rugged to fill it, ~~cleared~~ ^{chased} up Decs & stood off for the night Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same In the forenoon got off a Raft of Water

Wednesday Feb 26th

478

Begins with fair breeze from E.S.E. weather good Back in the last of the Water, ran around the Island, Sept in, and got off three Boat load of Wood, at sunset stood off for the night Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather about the same Forenoon got off three loads of Wood and sent the Boats for more So Ends

Thursday Feb 27th

479

Begins with strong Wind from E.S.E. & squally, could not keep the Ship up to the Land, at 4 P.M. the Boats got on board half loaded being all they could bring, Reefed the Topsails and came down to Snug sail for the night Strong Wind & Dirty Weather, Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same, at turn of the Tide, got under the Land, in smooth Water, & took off six load of Wood. So Ends

Friday Feb 28th

480

Begins with very strong Winds from E.S.E. with Rugged Weather Ship under all the sail we can carry, trying to get around to the Town, Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same, by working with the Tide, got to the Town in the forenoon found there was landing, but it was too Rugged to lower a Boat so stood off again So Ends

Saturday Mar 1st

481

Begins with strong E. & Wind & Rugged Weather Ship under Reefed Topsails, Staysails & fribb This afternoon stood in to the Town, and sent in a Boat, at 4 P.M. the Boat came on board stood off for the night Middle part more Moderate Made some sail Latter part strong breeze & good Weather stood in for the Town & sent the Starboard Watch on Liberty, then ran around the Island to finish Wooding So Ends

Sunday Mar 2nd

482

Begins with Moderate Wind from E.S.E. with good Weather, at 3 P.M. got the Wood all on board, down Jacks & started for Town again Middle & Latter parts Moderate breeze & fine Weather Ship too Windward of the Island, off & on.

Monday Feb 3rd

483

Begins with Moderate Winds from E.S.E. with fine Weather at 5 P.M. sent a Boat for the watch on Shore, but it was bad landing & she came off without the Men. stood off Shore for the night at 11 P.M. Starboard watch Common Board, at 4 P.M. part Watch went on Shore

Tuesday Mar 4th

first this day Begins with a Moderate Breeze from East Ship laying off and on the Island in sight all night but I day light, at Oct in Hazy and thick at day light land lost too. kept to the Windward of till 1 P.M. then in Show no Boat come off ward & off Shore with dark stormy land Show men could not see anything, at daylight land lost too. So Ends

Wednesday Mar 5th

first part Heavy Weather Wind East stood in Shore.

at 5 P.M. Boat come off with Watch. all come off but the Captain and mate and 3 Men were Ship Round the North Side of the Island with the Land. Continues laying off and Weather thick and hazy at 10 in the night Commenced to Blow strong from East with much Rain at daylight Ship under a
