Friday, Mar. 7th
This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W.E.,
made all sail heading to the S.E. with all sail set
at 10 a.m. were ship heading N.W.E.
latter part set in thick at 4 p.m. to the N.W.E.
were ship to the Eastward. at 6 p.m. Cloud thick
weather. So Ends this day. Lat. 29° 12' South
40 Miles by Longitude to the Eastward
of the Island.

Saturday, Mar. 8th
First part Calm and thick and foggy weather.
The Watch employed in ship's duty.
Middle part do.
latter part Thick and heavy with a small breeze
from the S.E. Bark heading by the to the S.E. W.
got no altitudes So Ends this day.

Sunday, Mar. 9th
First part Moderate Breeze and pleasant
Ship heading S.E. with the wind from
the Eastward.
middle and latter dark and heavy all possible
sail set. at 8 p.m. got a altitude.
at noon got a latitude at 7 p.m. were ship to
Northward. Lat 29° 57' South.

Monday, March 10th 490
Begins with light breeze from S.E. with foggy
weather Ship under all sail working in for the
land Middle & latter part, the same

Tuesday, March 11th 491
Begins with land & weather the same at 11th
saw the land ahead, stood in until sunset
it being too late to send in a Boat, stood off for the
night Middle part light breeze & good weather
latter part same Early this morning sent in a Boat
which soon came off bringing all the Men on board
except one Frenchman that he shipped at the boat
board, who has deserted from the ship So Ends

Wednesday, Mar 12th 492
Begins with strong breeze from East with fair
weather, at 4 P.M. got everything on board, and
the Capt came aboard, started off 2 by 8 Under
moderate sail Middle & latter parts light breeze
from East with Breeze weather Ship under all
sail heading S.E. Lat 30° 14 Long 168° 23

Thursday, Mar 13th 493
Begins with light breeze from East, with
good weather Ship under all ^{top} steering by
to S.E. Middle & latter parts strong breeze
from South with squally weather So Ends

Friday, Mar 14th 494
Begins with strong breeze from South, with
squally weather Ship under all sail heading
S.E. at dark furled the light sails
Middle & latter parts Wind & weather
the same Ship under topsails & courses
Course S.E.
