Monday April 21st 5.31
Begins Calm & Cloudy Weather. Middle
& Latter parts good breeze from East
With Cloudy Weather. Ship Under all sail
steering off to the N.W. No Obs

Tuesday April 22nd 5.32
Begins With fresh breeze from N.E. With
Rainy Weather Steering off to the West
At dark shortened sail & came to the Wind
on the Starboard Tack. Middle & Latter
parts Moderately Gale from N.E. With steady
Rain Storm. Ship Under close Reefed Main
Topsail & Storm Staysails

Wednesday April 23rd 5.33
Begins With Gale from N.E. With Torrents
of Rain. Ship Hereby heading S.E. at 7 P.M.
Wind hauled to N.W. in a heavy Squall which
lasted about one hour, blowing very heavy
then gradually moderated to light breeze With
heavy Sea on Middle & Latter parts Nearly Calm

Thursday April 24th 5.34
Begins With light breeze from West With
heavy swell on. Ship Under Topsails & Courses
Cruising Middle part Under the same
Latter part strong breeze from South & Rainy
Lat 31:21 Long 175:05

Friday April 25th 5.35
Begins With strong Wind from South With
Rugged Weather Middle part the Wind
hauled to West With strong breeze & Squally
Weather Latter part the same. Steering
to the South

Begins With fresh breeze from West With fair
Whaling Weather Ship Under all sail
steering S.E. Spoke Bk Addison of New
Bedford, Buzzards, Master. One other Sail
in sight. Middle & Latter parts strong
Winds from West With Rugged Weather

Monday April 28th 5.38
Begins With strong Winds from West. With
Rugged Weather Ship Under Reefed Topsails
heading to the South Middle & Latter parts
Under more moderate from same quarter
Lat 33:11 Long 176:48

Tuesday April 29th 5.39
Begins With good breeze from West. With
good Weather Ship Under all sail standing
to the South Spoke Bk Rainbow of New
Bedford. Gray. Master. 30 Months out With
S.E. Bk all tops. Middle & Latter parts, light
breeze from West With good Weather

Wednesday April 30th 5.40
Begins With light breeze from West, With
good Weather Ship Under all sail
steering to the N.E. Middle & Latter parts
Calm. Sent down the Fore sail for
Repairs
