

Bk Mary Frasier, Of New Bedford, Mass,

Friday May 30th

This day strong breeze from S.W. and some Showers
Broke out some oil and got it ready to ship
but could not haul alongside of the Eliza, on
account of the wind

Saturday May 31st

Nearly Calm all day with good weather, At day
light the Eliza hauled alongside, Put on board
2.40 Bbls of Oil Broke out some more and Cooped
it ready for Monday.

Sunday June 1st

Good weather and Calm all day, Sent on
Watch on Liberty until sunset, and all returned
but one, David Roberts Green Hand deserted

Monday June 2nd

Nearly Calm with good weather Put some oil on
Board of the Eliza making a finish of it and
12.00 Pounds of Right Whale Bone, and at 4 P.M.
She hauled away,

Tuesday June 3rd

Good weather Got off a Raft of Water, Stowed one
Side of the Ground Tier and other Work Second
Officer Sick with bad cold & Head ache

Wednesday June 4th

Good weather and Nearly Calm, Finished Stowing
Ground Tier Filled one Side got of two Rafts of Water
and got ready to haul the Ship to repair the Sheathing
& Copper on the Starboard side

Thursday June 5th

Morning Calm, At daylight began to haul the Ship
but by 10 o'clock the wind was so strong from
the S.W. had to right her up again, commenced
Painting Outside

Friday June 6th

Began Calm with good weather At daylight
Hauled the Ship & Breaker Repaired Sheathing
Put on 15 Sheets of Copper in good shape and
Brighted Ship, and filled the Ground Tier on the
Starboard side

Saturday June 7th

Light breeze & good weather Got off a Raft of Water
Stowed it took on board 11 Pieces of Beef & Stowed off
after Hold, and other Work

Sunday June 8th

To day good weather with light breeze Sent Port Watch
on Liberty, At Sunset all returned

Monday June 9th

To day good weather Sent in a Raft of Casks for
Water but it ran so slow did not get it filled until
dark, Blacked the Benches Set up Shakes & other Work
& Carpenter at Work Caulking around the Stern

Tuesday June 10th

To day, good weather and light breeze from S.W.
Got off a Raft of Water and Stowed it, also Potatoes
and Flour from Shore, and sent another Raft
on Shore Last Night, Joseph Silva Green Hand, Went
on Shore in the Boat, and has not been on board as
yet, Supposed deserted. To day the Carpenter got
through his Job on the Bow,

Wednesday June 11th

Began Calm with good weather Sent Starboard
Watch on Liberty, Got off a Raft of Water & Stowed
it, finished all the Work between decks At dark
Watch came on board

Thursday June 12th

Good weather Sent the Port Watch on Liberty
Ship ready for Sea, At dark Watch came on
board, Except, Frank Bowers, & Martin Blair
Seamen, who got into a drunken Row, on Shore
and were detained by the Police
