To day strong breeze from S.W. With good weather Ship ready for sea, waiting for men, This afternoon David Roberts, who deserted some 13 days ago, was sent on board, also Frank Bowers, who was locked up for disturbing the Peace, Martin Blair, for drawing a Knife on a Native, on Shore, was taken out of the Ship by the authorities, and held for Trial, at Auckland.

Saturday, June 14th

5.84

To day bright air, and Calm, at 10 A.M. Hoove sport and set the sails, expecting to leave at once but the Consul protesting against the liberation of Martin Blair, he was brought to Trial this afternoon and let off, with a Fine of Five Pounds & Costs, and sent on board, to Night. Being to late to sail, Furlled the sails and Paid out Chain to 45 fathoms,

Sunday, June 15th

5.85

To day Calm all day, With fine weather, all Hands on board. Afternoon the Capt and Wife, come on board, ready for an early start in the morning

Monday, June 16th

5.86

Forenoon Calm and Cloudy, With Head Tide at 11 A.M. Tide turned fair, and a nice breeze sprang up from S.W. Took our anchor and went to Sea, So ended Monday, With 12 hours Civil Set,

Tuesday, June 17th Sea bet

Begins With fine breeze from S.W. With good weather Ship standing out to Sea steering N.E. by N. Showed the anchors and cables, Washed off Decks Chose Watches, and made all snug, Discharged at Port Russell, John Pagne, Cooper, who exchanged James Anderson, Boatsteerer Sick, on the Consuls hands, and lost by desertion, Joseph Silva, Green Hand Shipped, James Mahony, Cooper, Jeremiah Conolly, George Dobbins, and David Pearson, Seamen, and found on board, one Steward, named, William Harrison, Nailing from Hobart Town, Tasmania.

Begins With strong breeze from W.S.W. With good weather Ship Under all sail steering E.N.E. Sent down Fore Topsail to Repair Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather same

Begins With strong breeze from S.W. With Cloudy weather, Ship Under all sail steering N.E. Middle part Wind hauled to East, With strong breeze & squally weather Latter part same

Begins With strong breeze from East, With squally weather, Ship Under all sail by the Wind to N.N.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same
