Friday July 4th

604
Begins with strong breeze from East with
rainy weather. Ship under topsails, steering
into the S.W. Middle & latter parts wind & weather
the same No Obs

Saturday July 5th

605
Begins with strong winds from East. With
squally weather. Ship under reefed topsails
and courses, on the Southern Tack. Middle
and latter parts wind the same with clear
weather & rugged. At daylight bore ship
to the North Lat 26:34 South, Long 175:45 East

Sunday July 6th

606
Begins with strong Easterly winds with clear
weather and rugged. Exhaling. Middle
part wind hauled to North; latter part wind
the same with steady rain

Monday July 7th

607
Begins with moderate breeze from North and
hailing to the Westward, with steady pouring
rain. Ship bore to under storm sail on the
N.E. tack. Middle part wind hauled to S.W.
and moderated to light breeze and clear weather
latter part the same. Made all sail and kept
off steering N.E. Lat 25:46 Long 174:57 West

Tuesday July 8th

608
Begins with light breeze from S.W. with good
weather. Ship under all sail steering N.E.
At 5 P.M. spoke ship Calafornia, of New
Bedford, Grace, Master. Middle part Calm
latter part light breeze from N.N.W. with
cloudy weather heading to N.E. under
all sail No Obs

Wednesday July 9th

609
Begins with good breeze from N.N.W. with
rainy weather. Ship under all sail
heading N.E. Middle & latter parts nearly
Calm with clear weather
Lat 25:00 Long 173:13 West

Thursday July 10th

610
Begins with light airs from S.E. with fine
weather. Ship under all sail, steering
N.E. Middle and latter parts wind and
weather the same Lat 24:38 Long 172:44

Friday July 11th

611
Begins with fresh breeze from S.E. with
fine pleasant weather. Ship under all
sail steering N.E. Employed painting boats
Middle & latter parts light breeze & good weather
Lat 23:24 Long 172:24

Saturday July 12th

612
Begins with light breeze from S.E. with fine
weather. Ship under all sail. Course N.E.
Middle part, the wind hauled to N.N.W. with
fresh breeze and good weather. Latter part same
heading N.E. on port tack.
Lat 22:46 Long 171:23

Sunday July 13th

613
Begins with fresh breeze from N.N.W. with
good weather. Ship under all sail heading
N.E. Borel to the Island of Java for
Wampbacks. Middle part wind strong
from W.N.W. Latter part same with squally
weather heading North under topsails and
courses Lat 21:17 Long 170:38
