Thursday July 24th 624
To day, Nearly Calm all day, Lowered
four Boats Whaling, But three Whales seen
Our Bow Boat had a good chance to strike
a Cow Whale, and the Boatsteerer Missed
The Capt. gives him but one more Trial

Friday, July 25th 625
To day, Lowered four Boats & Cruised untill
9 A.M. Weather Bginy and thick, came on Board
at 12 M. Weather Cleared, with fine breeze from
South Lowered again, and Cruised untill Sun
set No Whales seen to day

Saturday, July 26th 626
This day, Forenoon Bginy, to 10 A.M. rest of the
day, good Weather, with light breeze from South
Boats down from all the Ships, Saw No Whales

Sunday July 27th 627
To day Strong breeze from S.E. with cloudy wea-
ther Nothing doing

Monday July 28th 628
To day strong breeze from S.E. with clear weather
Sent two Boats Whaling, Sent down Topgallant
yards & Sails & Unbent the Main Course, Broke
out Provisions Early in the Afternoon the Boats
Returned, Saw No Whales

Tuesday July 29th 629
To day strong breeze & Bggyed with squally
Weather One of the Martha's Boats, Struck a
Whale, that ran back, No other Boat could get
to him, Outside of the Main Keel he cut him
and returned to the Ship

Wednesday July 30th 630
To day good Weather Four Boats from each
Cruised all day Three Whales seen
None struck

Thursday July 31st 631
To day, Nearly Calm all day One Whale
got to the Martha's Boats with a Number
of Whales seen, No more struck for want
of Wind, Prospect altogether more cheering

Friday July Aug 1st 632
To day good Weather with light breeze from
S.E. No Whales seen, from any of the Boats
At dark strong Wind from South
at 9 P.M. Blowing fresh & Squally, Set up
the second anchor Under foot

Saturday Aug 2nd 633
This forenoon Wind & Weather about the
same with some rain, Afternoon more
Moderate, Saw a Whale a short distance
from the Ship, Lowered two Boats from us
and two from the Rainbow, and chased
untill sunset, did not strike.

Sunday Aug 3rd 634
To day, Strong breeze from South, with Squally
thick weather & steady Rain, Nothing Doing.

Monday Aug 4th 635
To day fresh breeze from South, Lowered two
Boats, and went down the Bay, to look for a
Whale, soon after, the Wind hauled to North
with plenty of Rain, came on board afternoon
Wind hauled to S.W. with steady Rain, took
our second anchor, to prevent it fouling.

Tuesday Aug 5th 636
To day good breeze from S.W. with good Weather
Four Boats Whaling all day, Three Whales
seen. None struck
