Begins with Moderate breeze from S.W.  
With cloudy weather & heavy swell, Ship  
Under all sail heading S.E. Middle part  
Wind the same, Waze Ship to W.N.W.  
Latter part light breeze from S.S.W. heading  
West Lat 29:30 Long 176:48 East

Saturday Nov 4th 724  
Begins with light breeze from S.S.W. with  
cloudy weather Ship Under all sail heading  
West Employed Repairing and painting  
the Boats Middle & Latter parts light breeze  
from South to East, with fine weather  
Lat 30:00 Long 175:29 East

Sunday Nov 2nd 725  
Begins with light airs from East with  
good weather, Ship Under all sail  
steering S.S.W. Middle & Latter parts Wind  
and weather the same Lat 30:41 Long 175:05

Monday Nov 3rd 726  
Begins with light breeze from East with  
good weather Ship Under all sail steering  
S by W. At dark took in light sails & Courses  
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather same

Tuesday Nov 4th 727  
Begins with light breeze from N.E. with fine  
weather Ship Under all sail steering S.W. by S.  
Middle & Latter parts Breeze Calm, with fine  
weather Lat 31:55 Long 173:40

Wednesday Nov 5th 728  
Begins with light breeze from S.S.W. with  
good weather Ship Under all sail heading  
West Middle & Latter parts Strong Wind  
from South with clear weather  
Lat 31:12 Long 171:24 East

Thursday Nov 6th 729  
Begins with Strong winds from South with  
clear weather Ship Under all sail steering  
West by North, At dark Shortened sail  
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather the same  
Course W.N.W. Lat 29:58 Long 169:14

Friday Nov 7th 730  
This day begins with good breeze from  
S.S.E. with good weather Ship Under all sail  
steering W.N.W. Middle part at 11 P.M. saw  
Norfolk Island, hauled aback and lay  
until daylight Latter part Wind & weather  
the same, At daylight kept off for the  
North side of the Island, Five Sails in  
sight, all standing in for the Land, at  
10 A.M. saw Humpbacks, Cow & Calf  
Lowered three Boats, soon after struck, to  
the Waist, Boat killed the Cow and at  
12 M. took her alongside So Ends

Saturday Nov 8th 731  
Begins with fine breeze from E.N.E. with  
good weather Employed Cutting at 6  
P.M. finished Cutting and Braced foreward  
on the Starboard tack, heading off shore  
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather same  
Emp Boiling

Sunday Nov 9th 732  
Begins with good breeze from N.E. with cloudy  
weather Cruising on the North side of the Island  
Eight Sails in sight. Spoke Bk Elderson, Middle  
& Latter parts strong Wind from North
