Begins with strong wind from North, with cloudy weather Ship under topsails & courses on the south side of the Island, 25 miles from the Land. Saw several Manxbacks all going to Windward. At dark shortened sail Middle part wind died out to Calm. Latter part same with fine weather. Stowed down the oil. The Whale making 36 Barrels

Begins nearly Calm with good weather. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from N.W. with good weather Ship under all sail steering S.W.

Wednesday Nov 12th

Begins with light breeze from N.W. with hazy weather Ship under all sail steering S.W. At dark shortened sail. One sail in sight Middle part more wind. Ship on Eastern tack. Latter part strong breeze from N.N.E. Made all sail and steered off W by South weather thick and hazy No Obs

Thursday Nov 13th

7.36
Begins with strong winds from N.N.E. with thick rainy weather. Course W by South. At dark shortened sail. Plenty of Rain all night. Latter part good breeze from West with clear weather.

Begins with good breeze from West with fair weather Ship under all sail heading S.W. Middle and latter parts strong winds from same quarter and squally.

Monday Nov 17th

Begins with wind hauling some to the South At 7 P.M. Tacked to N.W. under all sail Middle & latter parts strong winds from South to S.W. heading West & W by N
Lat 35:45 Long 162:22

Tuesday Nov 18th

7.41
Begins with strong winds from S.W. with squally weather Ship under topsails & courses heading West. Middle part wind died out to Calm. Latter part same with cloudy weather and some Rain No Obs

Wednesday Nov 19th

7.42
Begins with Calm. At 3 P.M. wind came out from East with good breeze and plenty of Rain steering W.S.W. under all the sail that will draw One Merchant Bark in sight Bound West. Middle part weather the same. Latter part wind the same with clear weather steering W.S.W.
