Begins with Moderate breeze from East with fine
pleasant weather Ship under all sail Cruising
At 3 P.M. Saw a lone Whale going to Windward
Lowered four Boats in Chase. Saw the Whale two
times from the Boats, and then lost sight of
him. Saw him from the Ship and recalled the Boats
but they did not get back until Sunset
Middle & Latter parts light breeze from N.N.W.
with good weather

Begins with strong breeze from North with
good weather Ship under all sail Steering to
the South. Middle & Latter parts strong Wind from
North with thick foggy weather No Obs

Begins with strong Winds from North with thick
foggy weather Ship under short sail heading to
the West. Middle and Latter parts Wind of
the same with Rainy Weather

strong Wind and heavy squalls of Rain At dark
put the Ship under close Reefed Main Topsail and
Staysails Middle part Wind Moderated and
hauled to S.W. Latter part strong Winds from

Western tack under Topsails & Courses
