Sunday Jan 1st

This day begins with Moderate breeze from S.E. with good weather Ship under all sail beating up to Cape Pillar. At sunset becalmed, 15 miles from the Land the Cape bearing West, Middle part Calm. At day light had good breeze from S.W. for a few hours Working Ship up to the Cape So Ends

Monday Jan 5th

Begins with light airs, and baffling, and Calms untill 4 P.M. when light breeze sprung up from N.E. with some rain. At sunset Cape Pillar on the Starboard beam, bearing North. Got up the cables and bent them, and anchors off the Bow. Etc. Middle part at 4 P.M. took the wind from South and went into the Bay. At 2 A.M. passed the Light, and came to Anchor off the City at 5 A.M. So Ends Sea bet

Monday Jan 5th Civil Act

At 5 A.M. came to Anchor with Best Bower and 40 fathoms of Chain Brought out some Shooks & washed the Ship Outside. At Night Watch on Shore on Liberty

Tuesday Jan 6th

To day light breeze and weather Emp. Breaking out oil & setting up Shooks. At Night Watch on Liberty

Wednesday Jan 7th

This Twenty four hours good weather & light breeze Employed at various jobs. At Night Watch on Liberty

Thursday Jan 8th

This day good weather and light winds Employed Breathing out Fore Peak and Stowing Ground in Fore Hold. At Night Watch on Liberty

Friday Jan 9th

This day good weather and strong breeze Employed Tarring the Riggers, setting up Shooks and other work. At Night Watch on Liberty

Saturday Jan 10th

This day good weather and strong breeze from South Employed setting up Shooks, finished Tarring, and painted one side of the Ship outside. At Night, Watch on Liberty

Sunday Jan 11th

This day good weather with light breeze, Watch on Liberty

Monday Jan 12th

This day good weather with light breeze at 9 A.M. the Steamer took us into the Wharf. Made fast & discharged 100 bbls of oil. At Night, Watch on Liberty

Tuesday Jan 13th

This day Calm with good weather Taking on board Flour & Bread.

Wednesday Jan 14th

This day good weather with light breeze Took on board Wood, and part of the Beef. This Morning Three Men Missing, Martin Blair, Francisco Espanoz and William Worsell, Supposed Deserted, all Seamen,

Thursday Jan 15th

This day good weather Employed Filling & Stowing Water & Stowing After Hold. This Morning Manuel & Filoa Seaman, Missing, Supposed Deserted,

Friday Jan 16th

This day good weather with light breeze Took on board the remainder of our Water and stowed it, also of the Bread and a lot of small Stores and are all ready to haul off in the Stream as soon as we get the rest of our Meat by Steamer

Saturday Jan 17th

This day Steady Rain all day Nothing doing

Sunday Jan 18th

This day good weather gave all hands Liberty except one Officer to look out for the Ship
