This day Fine weather with light breeze, took on board the Balance of our Meat and all the Rest of our Small Store, and at Night were all ready to haul into the Stream. This Morning, Charles Sege & Marvail Rum, Seamen were Missing, supposed Deserted,

Tuesday Jan 20th 804
This day good weather with strong breeze from South at 10 A.M. took the Steamer, & were towed into the Stream Francis Lester, Steward, Missing this Morning supposed Deserted

Wednesday Jan 21st 805
This day good weather with strong breeze Employed Painting Ship Outside Afternoon Charles Sege & Marvail Rum brought on board by the Police.

Thursday Jan 22nd 806
This day Strong breeze from S.E. with good weather at 10 A.M. Took on board part of our Potatoes then got Underweigh and went down the River five Miles and came to, again. With Best Bower & 50 fathoms of Chain, Waiting for Men. & Potatoes

Friday Jan 23 807
This day light breeze from South with good weather Ship at anchor 5 miles from Hobart Town in the River. At 10 A.M. Barge came down bringing 30 Bags of Potatoes also four Men for the Ship. Afternoon Boat came, bringing two more Men.

Saturday Jan 24th 808
This day good weather with good breeze from S.E. Afternoon Boat came from Town bringing two Men

Sunday Jan 25th 809
This day Fine weather with good breeze from S.E. waiting for the Capt & some Men. To day two Men were brought on Board

Monday Jan 26th 810
This day Strong breeze from S.E. with fair weather Ship all ready for Sea waiting for Men & the Capt

Tuesday Jan 27th 811
This day good weather with light breeze all day this Morning two Men Missing, must have Swam on Shore during the Night At 6 P.M. Capt, came on board

Wednesday Jan 28th 812
Clear day Forenoon Boat came from Town with some stores for the Ship Afternoon Boat came with the two Men that Swam on Shore Monday Night in charge of the Police. Strong breeze blowing in & thick weather

Thursday Jan 29th 813
At 4 A.M. Got Underweigh with a light breeze from the Land, with fine weather forenoon wind light & variable Working Ship out of the River to Endeavour Thursday with 12 hours Civil time

Friday Jan 30th Sea Act, 814
Begins with fresh breeze from S.E. with good weather Beating Ship out of Storm Bay At 4 P.M. got a good breeze from S.W. Steaming S.E. At dark all clear Stowed the Anchors & Chains and made all snug for the Night Midle and latter parts strong wind from S.W. with rugged weather; took in light sails

Saturday Jan 31st 815
Begins with strong breeze from S.W. with fair weather Steaming N.E. by E. At sunset the wind had died to Calm. Made part At 7 P.M. got a breeze from South which blew on to a moderate Gale latter part the same Steaming N.N.E. Under Reefed Topsails
