Begins with Moderate breeze from S.S.W. With clear weather Ship Under Reefed Top sails & Courses Steering N.E. Middle part Wind moderated to strong breeze latter part same Made all sail Course the same Lat 39:21

Monday Feb 2nd

817
Begins with Moderate breeze from S.S.W. With good weather Ship Under all sail Steering N.E. Middle part Wind hauled to N.W. With strong breeze & thick Hazy weather latter part same, heading N.E. Under Top sails & Courses

Tuesday Feb 3rd

818
Begins with strong breeze from N.W. With Hazy weather Wind gradually hauling to Southward at dark Wind S.S.W. Steering N.N.E. Middle part Wind hauled Round to S.E. latter part strong breeze from East With thick weather Lat 36:49 Long 155:02

Wednesday Feb 4th

819
Begins with strong Easterly winds & Hazy weather Ship Under all sail heading by the Wind to Northward Middle part Wind hauled to N.N.E. at daylight bore Ship to Eastward latter part Wind the same Lat 35:36 Long 156:48

Thursday Feb 5th

820
Begins with strong breeze from North Ship Under all sail heading E.N.E. Middle part more Wind, took in light sails, latter part Wind the same With Hazy weather Ship heading E.N.E. Lat 35:30 Long 155:40

Friday Feb 6th

821
Begins with strong winds from North, With Hazy weather. Ship Under Reefed Top sails & Courses heading E.N.E. At 2 P.M. bore Ship to W.N.W. Middle & latter parts Wind & weather the same Lat 35:00 Long 154:45

Saturday Feb 7th

822
Begins with good breeze from North with fair weather Ship Under all sail working to Windward Two Whalers in sight. Middle part & latter part Wind the same At 7 A.M. saw a Sperm Whale lowered four Boats in Chase got nearly on with the Larboard Boat but the Whale saw the Boat & did not strike and the Whale went to Windward

Sunday Feb 8th

823
Begins with good breeze from N.N.E. With good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Spoke Bark Asia of Hobart Town Middle & latter parts Wind & weather the same Lat 34:48 Long 158:46

Monday Feb 9th

824
Begins with Moderate Wind from North With good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Saw Bark Hunter of New Bedford Cutting Middle part Wind & weather the same latter part Wind the same With thick Rainy weather Ship on the Eastern tack

Tuesday Feb 10th

825
Begins with good breeze from North With thick Rainy weather At 4 P.M. Wind hauled to West and weather clearing Saw Bark Asia of Hobart Town take a dead Whale alongside & let it go again, suppose it was bad to Gent Middle & latter parts the same
