Begins With Moderate breeze from West With good weather. Ship on the Northern tack. Emp. Boiling Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather same

Sunday Feb 22nd

833

Begins With Wind & Weather the same At dark finished Boiling One Whale in sight. Middle part Wind hauled to East and increased to Moderate Gale Latter part Wind the same With Rainy Weather No Obs

Monday Feb 23rd

834

Begins With Gale from East With steady Rain storm Ship hove too on the Northern tack. Under close reefed Main Topsail and Staysails. Middle part Wind Moderated to Strong breeze, and weather cleared up Latter part same At daylight commenced Hoving down Oil To Ends

Tuesday Feb 24th

835

Begins With Moderate breeze from S.E. With light squally weather At dark finished Hoving. The two Whales Making 9 barrels Middle & Latter parts Wind and Weather the same Emp Washing Ship Lat 34:55

Wednesday Feb 25th

836

Begins Calm. At 4 P.M. got a light breeze from S.E. With Rainy weather. Middle part the Wind increased to Moderate Gale. Latter part the same With squally weather Ship on the Eastern tack

Thursday Feb 26th

837

Begins With Gale from South and squally Ship hove too on Eastern tack. Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same

Begins With Moderate Gale from South With heavy swell At 4 P.M. bore Ship to the Westward. Middle part Wind hauled to S.E. and Moderated to good breeze Latter part same With good weather

Begins With good breeze from East. With good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Middle and Latter parts. good breeze from North With good weather

Sunday March 1st

Begins With Strong breeze from North With good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Middle part same. Latter part Moderate breeze from North to West With good weather

Begins With light variable Winds from W to S.W. and Showery weather Ship Under all sail. Cruising Middle & Latter parts Strong Winds from S.E. and Rugged

Tuesday March 3rd

842

Begins With strong Winds from S.E. With Rugged weather Ship Under Topsails & Courses heading E.N.E. Saw two Whalers today Middle & Latter parts same Lat 34 47 Long 158:10

Wednesday March 4th

843

Begins With strong S.E. Winds & Rugged With clear weather Ship Under Topsails & Courses. Cruising Middle & Latter Wind strong from East With thick Hazy weather Hauling to N.E.
