& Latter parts light breeze from North with fine
weather Lat 32:08 Long 171:10

Friday March 20th 859
Begins with light breeze from North with fine
weather Ship under all sail heading to Eastward
Middle & Latter parts nearly Calm with
Showery weather

Begins with good breeze from E.S.E. with good
weather Ship under all sail heading N.E.
Middle & Latter under the same with squally

weather Ship under Top sails & courses heading
N.E. At dark shortened sail. Middle & Latter
parts under the same at day light
tacked to the South

Monday March 23rd 862
Begins with moderate breeze from E.S.E. with
good weather Ship under all sail heading
South at dark shortened sail & tacked to
N.E. Middle & Latter parts Strong under
from same quarter

Tuesday March 24th 863
Begins with strong winds from S.E. with
clear weather Ship under nearly all sail
working to Windward Middle & Latter parts
More wind from same quarter
Lat 30:37 Long 173:26

Wednesday March 25th 864
Begins with very strong winds from S.E.
with thick squally weather Ship under Reef &
Top sail heading E.N.E. At dark Moderate
Gale. Middle & Latter parts Moderate Gale with
squally rainy weather No 662

Thursday March 26th 865
Begins with moderate Gale from S.E. with Rainy
squally weather heading E.N.E. Under
short sail Middle part More Moderate
Latter part good breeze from S.E. with fair
weather Made all sail Lat 29:57
