Middle & Latter parts same.
Lat 31:14 Long 176:28

Thursday April 9th 879
This day begins with good breeze from E.S.E.
with good weather Ship under all sail Cruising
To day began fitting the Rigging Middle and
Latter parts Wind & Weather about the same
Lat 31:31 Long 176:44

Friday April 10th 880
Begins with moderate winds from E.S.E.
with showery weather Ship under all sail
Cruising Middle & Latter parts Strong wind
from same quarter Took in light sails and
Reefed the Topsails

Saturday April 11th 881
Begins with strong winds from E.S.E. with
clear weather Ship under Reefed Topsails
and Courses on the Western tack At dark bore
Ship to the N.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind
More Moderate & hauling to the South at day
light Made all sail

Sunday April 12th 881
Begins with good breeze from South with good
weather Ship under all sail on Eastern tack
Middle part Wind the same Latter part
Nearly Calm with rain & squalls
Lat 32 00 Long 179:11

Monday April 13th 882
This day begins Calm with good weather
Middle & Latter parts the same

Tuesday April 14th 883
Begins Calm with a cloudy sky. Took
some Lunar Observations, and then to differ
some from the Chronometer. Middle & Latter
parts light breeze from W.N.W. with good
weather Course S by W. Lat 33:06 Long 178:46

Wednesday April 15th 884
Begins with light breeze from W.N.W. with
fine weather Ship under all sail Steering
S by W. Middle & Latter parts the same

Thursday April 16th 885
Begins with good breeze from West with good
weather Two Whalers in sight At 4 P.M.
Spoke Bark Hunter and Charles of New
Bedford. had seen no Whales lately
Latter part strong Westly Winds & Rugged
Lat 33:22 Long 179:00 East

Friday April 17th 886
Begins with strong winds from W.S.W. with
clear weather and Rugged Ship under Top
sails & Courses on the S.E. tack. Middle & Latter
parts Wind & Weather the same
Lat 33:43 Long 179:22

Saturday April 18th 887
Begins with strong winds from S.W. with
Rugged weather Ship under Reefed Topsails
& Courses. Spoke Bark Rainbow of New
Bedford. had taken 150 Spinn. Oil lately.
Middle part. Wind died out to Calm
Latter part the same with good weather
Lat 33:41 Long 179:10
