with good weather

Friday April May 1st 9.00
Begins with moderate breeze from E.N.E with
hazy weather. Ship under all sail Cruising
Three Whalers in sight. Bark Alaska Boiling
Middle part the same latter part stiff breeze
from North with thick rainy weather Noobs

Saturday May 2nd 9.01
Begins with good breeze from North with thick
rainy weather. Ship under short sail at dark
wind hauled to East. Weather clearing
Middle part wind increased to a gale with
thick rainy weather & heavy sea. latter part
the same Ship went under close reefed
Main Topsail & staysails on the Northern tack

Sunday May 3rd 9.02
Begins with the wind more moderate & sea
not so heavy. Ship lying well & making no water
Middle part the same latter part made some
sail & wore to the S.W.

Monday May 4th 9.03
Begins with strong winds from East with clear
weather but rugged. Ship under reefed Topsails
& Fore Course Cruising. Middle & latter parts same
Lat 32:26 Long 174:27

Begins with good breeze from E.S.E with
squally weather. Ship under all sail
Cruising Middle part same latter part wind
baffling & squally Lat 33:20 Long 176:11

Thursday May 7th 9.06
Begins with strong wind from East with
clear weather Ship under Topsails & Courses
Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same

Friday May 8th 9.07
Begins with wind & weather the same
Ship under Topsails & Courses heading on the
Southern tack. Middle & latter parts strong
breeze from E.S.E at daylight wore Ship to
N.E.

Saturday May 9th 9.08
Begins with strong wind from E.S.E with
rugged squally weather. Ship under double
reefed Topsails & staysails heading to N.E.
Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same
Lat 32:56

Sunday May 10th 9.09
Begins with wind more moderate from East
with clear weather Ship under Topsails and
Courses. Cruising Middle part the same
latter part good breeze from N.W.E with
cloudy weather. Ship under all sail heading
East
