Sunday June 21st Sea Account

Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. with cloudy weather
Ship under all sail steering N.E. by N. Stowed the
anchors & chains, washed off Decks & made all
drugs Middle & latter parts wind more moderate from
same quarter Course N.E. Lat 33:30

Monday June 22nd

Begins with wind & weather the same. Steering N.E.
Under all drawing sail. Middle & latter parts wind
light & hauling to the Northward. Course the same
The ship in good weather Seaking about 600 strokes
in Twenty four hours Lat 32:40 Long 178 East

Tuesday June 23rd

Begins with light breeze from North with cloudy
weather Ship under all sail heading E by N.
Middle & latter parts wind light and variable from
North to N.N.E. with good weather sent down
Fore Top gallant sail repaired & bent it again
Lat 31:46 Long 179:41 East

Wednesday June 24th

Begins with moderate wind from North. with
good weather Ship under all sail steering E by N.
Middle & latter parts same at daylight hauled up
steering N by E Lat 31:37 Long 177:53 West.

Thursday June 25th

Begins with light breeze from West with good
weather Ship under all sail steering N by E.
Middle part the same latter part calm
Lat 30:31

Friday June 26th

Begins calm with good weather Towards night got
light breeze from North. Made all sail heading E.N.E.
Middle part the same latter part strong winds
from North with rainy weather took in light sails
& reefed the Topsails and wore ship to W.N.W.

Saturday June 27th

Begins with strong winds from North & pouring rain
Ship under short sail heading W.N.W. at dark wind
hauled to West. weather clearing. wore ship to North
Middle & latter parts wind light and variable from
W to S.W. with plenty of rain No obs

Sunday June 28th

Begins with good breeze from West with thick rainy
weather Ship under short sail steering N by E.
Middle & latter parts strong winds from W.S.W.
with clear weather Lat 29:15 Long 176:11 West

Monday June 29th

This day begins with strong winds from W.S.W. with
squally weather Ship under reefed Topsail and
courses heading N.W. at dark shortened sail
Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same
Lat 27:39 Long 177:03

Tuesday June 30th

Begins with strong wind from South with clear
weather Ship under short sail steering from
N.W. by W. to N. by W. Middle & latter parts the same

Wednesday July 1st

Begins with fresh breeze from South with fair weather
Ship under all sail cruising at dark shortened
sail. repaired the jib & bent it again
Middle & latter parts baffling winds and
rainy weather Lat 26:40
