Saturday Aug 8th

999

This day good weather with light breeze from East. This morning cooled down. Six Boats off all day, and saw no Whales

Sunday Aug 9th

1000

This day good weather with good breeze from S.E. One Watch on Shore for Liberty

Monday Aug 10th

1001

This day Fine weather Forenoon with light breeze from East to N.E. Afternoon Squally. With strong breeze from North several Whales seen but Struck None

Tuesday Aug 11th

1002

This day light breeze from North. With good weather Saw several Whales but Struck None

Wednesday Aug 12th

1003

This day good weather with light airs from N.E. Plenty Whales seen. Got one to the Alaskan Boats. Whales ran and we tried to work with

Thursday Aug 13th

1004

This day Strong Wind from East with Rugged weather Forenoon, Struck a Whale to the Starboard Boat. Killed him, and while cutting a hole in his Head to Tow by, he sunk so heavy broke two Drips & parted one Line, and lost him. Afternoon Struck one to the Waist Boat and lost him by parting the Line. The Alaskan also Struck and lost one today

Friday Aug 14th

1005

This day Strong breeze from N.E. with good weather Struck a Whale to the Starboard Boat, and lost him after being fast two hours by the Iron drawing. No other Boat could get to him. The Alaskan lost one by Sinking alongside of the Ship, and parting the Fluke Chain

Saturday Aug 15th

1006

This day Nearly Calm with good weather. Several Whales seen but none Struck

Sunday Aug 16th

1007

This day Calm with good weather. One Watch on Shore for Liberty.

Monday Aug 17th

1008

This day light airs from N.E. around to West with Showery weather Saw some few Whales but got None.

Tuesday Aug 18th

1009

This day Strong Wind from South and Rugged Saw but few Whales and got None

Wednesday Aug 19th

1010

This day good breeze from S.E. with good weather But few Whales seen. Got one to the Alaskan Boats, and took it to the Alaskan.

Thursday Aug 20th

1011

This day Strong Winds from S.E. and Rugged weather No Whales seen today

Friday Aug 21st

1012

This day Windy & weather the same Saw no Whales

Saturday Aug 22nd

1013

This day Strong Winds & Rugged Squally weather Lowered four Boats. Saw a few Whales Did not Struck
