Sunday Aug 23rd 10.14
This day Strong winds from S.E. with clear weather
One Watch on Shore for Liberty

Monday Aug 24th 10.15
This day Forenoon. Wind Strong from East and
too Rugged to Lower Employed Pumping Fresh
Water from Ground Pipe. Afternoon, less wind
and better weather sent off two Boats Whaling
Saw two or three, but did not get one.

Tuesday Aug 25th 10.16
This day good breeze from North with good
weather. Eight Boats Chasing Whales all
day but did not strike any.

Wednesday Aug 26th 10.17
This day Calm Weather all day Plenty of
Whales. could not catch one

Thursday Aug 27th 10.18
This day good weather, with light breeze
from S.E. Got a Cow Whale to the Starboard
Boat took her to the Ship and began
cutting at dark Whale half in. Worked
down for the Night

Friday Aug 28th 10.19
This day Good weather with light breeze from S.E.
Got a Whale to the Starboard Boat and took it
to that Ship But few Whales seen

Saturday Aug 29th 10.20
This day Wind & weather the same.
Saw but few Whales did not strike
William Shaw, Seaman, being unwell, sent
him on Shore, for a week or two, to recruit his
health,

Sunday Aug 30th 10.21
This day Good weather with fresh breeze from S.E.
One Watch on Shore

Monday Aug 31st 10.22
This day Good weather with good breeze from East
Got a Whale to the Starboard Boat, hooked on with
Eight Boats, and after a hard Tow of fourteen
hours, got him to the Starboard. Struck one
to our Bow Boat, after being fast an hour or
two, Parted the line, and lost him

Tuesday Sept 1st 10.23
This day Good weather, and good breeze from
S.E. Saw a few Whales, but did not strike

Wednesday Sept 2nd 10.24
This day Good weather with light breeze from
S.E. But few Whales seen to day, none struck

Thursday Sept 3rd 10.25
This day Good weather with strong breeze
from South But few Whales seen. Struck
one to one of the Starboard Boats and lost
him by the parting of the line after being
fast about two hours. At Night blowing
strong from South with pouring rain

Friday Sept 4th 10.26
To day Forenoon Strong southerly wind and
rainy weather Saw a Cow and calf close to
the Ship. Weather to bad to Lower, at 12 M.
Wind died out to light breeze with clear weather
Lowered two Boats to look for the Cow.
at 4 P.M. struck her to the Starboard Boat
Killed her, and took her to our Ship
