Sunday Sept 20th

1042

This day Good weather and calm. Four men
Emp. Cutting. Afternoon sent one Watch
on Liberty

Monday Sept 21st

1043

This day Good weather with light airs
Very few Whales seen. None struck

Tuesday Sept 22nd

1044

This day Good weather with fine breeze from
East Saw a few Whales, but struck none

Wednesday Sept 23rd

1045

This day Good weather with light breeze from
S.E. Saw but few Whales. Struck one to
the West Boat, found he was likely to take
the Line, so held on hard, and parted it.

Thursday Sept 24th

1046

This day Good weather with fresh breeze
from S.E. Saw but two or three Whales, going
quick to the South. It begins to look as
though the season was about up

Friday Sept 25th

1047

This day Good weather with light breeze from
S.E. Saw but one or two Whales. Afternoon
Henry Saunders, Seaman, shipped at Hobart
Town, Desisted from one of the Boats, at an
Island called Ormo.

Saturday Sept 26th

1048

This day Good weather with wind the same
Saw but few Whales, struck none

So ends

Sunday Sept 27th

1049

This day Strong winds from S.E. with Rainy
weather one Watch on Liberty

Monday Sept 28th

1050

This day Wind the same with good weather
This Morning, the Mate went up to Ormo
and found that the Natives had caught our
Desister, Henry Saunders, paid them, five
dollars on demand, and brought the Man
on board. Saw two Whales to day, struck
one to the Starboard Boat, and took it to our
Ship

Tuesday Sept 29th

1051

This day Good weather with light S.E. winds
Sent two Boats to look for Whales. Saw but two
and did not strike. Disposed Parottnurships
with the Alaskan, she being about to leave
The seasons catch, being about 3.80 to each Ship

Wednesday Sept 30th

1052

This day Wind & weather the same. Employed
Boiling. Sent two Boats to look for Whales.
Saw but one, did not catch him.

Thursday Sept Oct 1st

1053

This day Calm. All hands on Board.
Employed Laying ground Tier in After Hold
Hewing some Oil. Etc.

Friday Oct 2nd

1054

This day Good weather with light airs
from North. No Whales seen. Employed at
Stowing down Oil and other work

Saturday Oct 3rd

1055

This day Good weather with light breeze
from North. Employed working Ship
Inside and Out
