This day begins with strong S.E. Trades and good weather. Steering S.W. by S. Employed fitting & painting the Boats Middle & latter parts. Wind moderate from same quarter. Made all sail  
Lat 23:08 Long 179 42 West

Saturday Oct 17th

This day begins with Moderate S.E. Winds and cloudy weather with some rain. Ship under all sail steering S.E. half South Middle & latter parts Wind the same. With Steady rain, Lat 24 00 Long 178.17 East

Sunday Oct 18th

Begins with weather clearing & good breeze from South. Ship under all sail heading W.S.W. at dark took in light sails Middle & latter parts Wind light & baffling from South to S.W. Ship on different tacks

Monday Oct 19th

Begins with Moderate breeze from S.S.W. with fair weather Ship under all sail on the S.E. tack. Middle part the same. Latter part Wind light from South. Wore Ship to W.S.W. Lat 24:29 Long 177:28.

Tuesday Oct 20th

This day begins with light winds from South with good weather Ship under all sail heading W.S.W. Middle & latter parts Wind moderate from S.E. With cloudy weather steering S.W.

Wednesday Oct 21st

Begins with Moderate breeze from S.E. with cloudy weather Ship under all sail steering S.W. Middle & latter parts same

Thursday Oct 22nd

This day begins with strong winds from S.E. with clear weather. Ship under all sail steering by to S.W. Middle & latter parts, Wind moderate from S.E. Course the same.  
Lat 26:59 Long 172:43

Friday Oct 23rd

Begins with Moderate breeze from S.E. with good weather Ship under all sail steering S.W. Middle & latter parts Wind & weather about the same Lat 27.44 Long 171.00

Saturday Oct 24th

Begins with light breeze from S.E. with good weather Ship under all sail heading S.W. Bound to Norfolk Island. Middle & latter parts Wind & weather the same  
Lat 28:32 Long 169:33

Sunday Oct 25th

Begins with Wind and weather the same Ship under all sail steering S.W. Middle & latter parts good breeze from S.E. at 9 A.M. Norfolk Island in sight steering S.S.W. for the Land

Monday Oct 26th

Begins with good breeze from S.E. with good weather Ship under all sail steering W.S.W. for the Land, at 4 P.M. took observations off Philips Island, and found the Chronometers out of the way about 15 miles, hauled off shore on the Southern tack Middle & latter parts Wind strong from E.S.E. with good weather at daylight wore Ship and stood over to the Town found it too rugged to land so stood off shore again  
So ended
