Begins With Strong breeze from East With cloudy weather Ship Under all sail (Cruising) Spoke Bark Sapphire Of Hobart Town, Fourteen Months out With 75 barrels Spruce Oil. Middle part Wind hauled to S.S.W. Latter part same With good weather Ship heading to the S.E. Lat 37:05 Long 156:24

Thursday Nov 19th 11.01
Begins With Moderate breeze from S.S.W. With good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather very changeable, Wind from all quarters With Rain & Sunshine

Friday Nov 20th 11.02
Begins With Moderate breeze from West With clear weather Mocha all sail heading S.S.W. Middle & Latter parts Changeable Winds & Weather Ship on different tacks

Saturday Nov 21st 11.03
Begins With Rainy Squally weather With Wind from different quarters from Calm to half a Gale Ship Under reefed Topsails. Middle part Wind died out to Calm Latter part light breeze from N.N.E. With good weather. Mocha all sail Lat 37:58 Long 156:20

Sunday Nov 22nd 11.04
Begins With Moderate Wind from N.N.E. and increasing With squally weather at 4 P.M. Blowing Moderate Gale, put the Ship Under close reefed Topsails Middle part heavy Gale Latter part more Moderate and Wind hauled to South With Low Barometer Steered off to the North So Ends

Monday Nov 23rd 11.05
Begins With Moderate Gale from South With Squally weather Ship Under close reefed Topsails & Foresail Steering North. At dark came to the Wind, on the Port Tack. Middle & Latter parts, Fresh Gale from same quarter. Ship Move too on same tack.

Tuesday Nov 24th 11.06
Begins With Fresh Gale from South With Squally weather Ship Move too Under close reefed Main topsail & Fore & Mizzen Staysails heading W.S.W. Middle part, Wind Moderated to strong breeze Latter part the same With heavy swell Made sail & kept off, Steering S.N.E. Lat 36:35 Long 156:50

Wednesday Nov 25th 11.07
This day begins With Strong breeze from South With clear weather Steering S.N.E. At dark shortened sail & luffed to heading S.S.E. Middle part Wind hauled to S.S.E. Latter part the same With cloudy weather. No Obs

Thursday Nov 26th 11.08
Begins With Strong Wind from S.S.E. With cloudy weather Ship Under Topsails and Courses, Cruising Middle & Latter parts Wind & Weather the same Lat 36:40 Long 156:38

Friday Nov 27th 11.09
Begins With Strong Winds from East With clear weather Ship Under reefed Topsails & Courses heading N.N.E. Middle & Latter parts Wind strong from S.N.E. and luffed With Wazy weather Ship on the S.E. tack
