Saturday Nov 28th

11.00

Begins with strong wind from E.N.E. with heavy weather and haggled, ship under reefed topsails & courses, heaving S.E. Middle and latter parts moderate breeze from N.E. with thick weather at daylight wore ship to N.W.

Sunday Nov 29th

11.11

Begins with moderate breeze from N.E. with thick heavy weather ship on the N.W. tack under reefed main topsail & staysails. Middle part the wind died out to calm latter part light breeze from South. Made all sail
Lat 35:25 Long 158:35

Monday Nov 30th

11.12

Begins with light breeze from S.E. with good weather ship under all sail, steering W.S.W. Middle part calm. Latter part light breeze from S.W. ship on the S.E. tack

Tuesday Dec 1st

11.13

Begins with light breeze from S.W. with fine weather but heavy swell ship under all sail, cruising Middle & latter parts wind & weather same
Lat 35:35 Long 158:45

Wednesday Dec 2nd

11.14

Begins with light breeze from East with good weather ship under all sail cruising Middle & latter parts strong breeze from South, weather the same

Thursday Dec 3rd

11.15

Begins with good breeze from South with good weather ship under all sail heaving W.S.W. at dark wore ship to E.S.E. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same Lat 35:55 Long 158:31

Friday Dec 4th

11.16

Begins with strong wind from South with clear weather ship under topsails and courses, cruising, at dark spoke bark Asia of Hobart Town. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same, steering off to N.E.

Saturday Dec 5th

11.17

Begins with strong southerly wind, with clear weather ship under reefed topsails and courses steering N.E. Middle part wind died out to calm. Latter part light breeze from East with fine weather. Last night Henry Brill, Seaman, maliciously threw overboard, some junk, and a broom, for doing which he was called to account this morning, when he was very fancy and used mutinous language. He was put at work in the try pot

Sunday Dec 6th

11.18

Begins with light breeze from East with fine weather ship under all sail cruising. To night Henry Brill was confined in Irons Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same

Monday Dec 7th

11.19

Begins with good breeze from South with good weather ship under all sail cruising spoke bark Hunter of New Bedford Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same Lat 35:05 Long 158:40

Tuesday Dec 8th

11.20

Begins with good breeze from South with fine weather ship under all sail on the Western tack Middle & latter parts moderate breeze from W.S.W. with fine weather steering South
Lat 35:40 Long 158:00
