Wednesday Dec 9th 11.21
This day begins with Moderate winds from N.W. With fine pleasant weather Ship under all sail Steering South Two Whalers in sight. Middle part. Wind hauled to East, weather the same

Thursday Dec 10th 11.22
Begins with light breeze from North with fine weather Ship under all sail Steering South. At dark Wind light from Eastward Released Henry Grill from Irons & sent him on duty. Middle & latter parts strong breeze from North with thick weather

Friday Dec 11th 11.23
Begins with strong winds from North with thick heavy weather Ship under Topsails & Courses. Cruising Middle & latter parts Wind the same with thick Rainy weather

Saturday Dec 12th 11.24
Begins with Northerly winds & rain. Ship under short sail. Middle part steady rain with Thunder & Lightning and strong wind which at latter part had increased to Fresh Gale

Sunday Dec 13th 11.25
Begins with Fresh Gale from N.W. with heavy Sea Ship under close reefed Main Topsail & Staysails on the S.W. tack Middle part Wind Moderated some latter part Moderate Gale with Squally weather

Monday Dec 14th 11.26
Begins with Moderate Gale from N.W. Middle part Wind hauled to S.W. and increased to heavy Gale latter part the same and Squally weather

Tuesday Dec 15th 11.27
This day begins with Fresh Gale from S.W. with heavy Squalls & dangerous Sea. Ship Wove too. Under close reefed Main Topsail and Fore Topmast & Mizen Staysails on Western tack. Middle part Wind Moderated some and latter part made some sail, and wore Ship to S.E. Lat 35.20 Long 158.10

Wednesday Dec 16th 11.28
Begins with strong winds from S.W. with heavy swell and clear weather Cruising Middle & latter parts Wind the same with Squally weather Steering off to the N.W. Lat 34.41 Long 157.07

Thursday Dec 17th 11.29
Begins with Wind strong from S.W. with Squally weather Ship under Topsails & Courses Cruising Middle & latter parts Moderate winds from same quarter with fine weather

Friday Dec 18th 11.30
Begins with Moderate breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather Ship under all sail Cruising Middle & latter parts Calm. Lat 34.20 Long 156.00

Saturday Dec 19th 11.31
Begins Calm, with Pleasant weather, Two Merchantmen in sight bound Eastward Middle & latter parts, Start Calm

Sunday Dec 20th 11.32
Begins with light breeze from N.W. with pleasant weather heading West with all sail. Put Joseph Lopez, Seaman, in Irons for fighting, and refusing to obey orders Middle & latter parts, strong winds from N.W. to West with some Thunder & Lightning
